# PROPERTY CHANGE REQUEST FORM

The form was created to address resident's questions regarding what is required for construction approval. It also simplifies the review process for the Board. Please take a moment to become familiar with the form. **Per Silver Creek deed restrictions, residents must request approval from the HOA board <u>prior to</u> construction to the outside of the property. The process is simple and there is a quick response if all information is provided up front. ### WHAT TIME DOES TRICK OR TREATING BEGIN IN SILVER CREEK?

Sunset in Louisville on Halloween 2022 will be around 6:45pm. This may affect when you want to head out to trick or treat....especially if you have little ones. Most counties have trick or treat times between 5-8pm though Jefferson County traditionally has not set specific hours. Silver Creek suggests trick or treating between the hours of 5pm - 8pm to safely venture out when its not quite so dark and be heading home before it is too dark.

Silver Creek is asking residents to Trick-or-Treat the safe way, as outlined in state provided guidelines. We do encourage washing/sanitizing your hands often.
