## Mailbox Standards

## Silver Creek Subdivision Residents' Association (Revised Q1 - 2021)

Mailbox and all support structure must be black in color. The Mailbox is a standard US metal mailbox.

Paper box is now optional
Paper box is made from $1^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ wood material.
The paper box width is $6^{\prime \prime}$, height is $9^{\prime \prime}$, and length is $18^{\prime \prime}$ Measurement from the top of the paper box to the top of the post is $14.5^{\text {" }}$

Paper box must also be black
Post is $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime}$ wood material - plus
$4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ for mailbox support
Measurement from the top of the paper box to the street the measurement must be $45^{\prime \prime}-50^{\prime \prime}$ in height.

The entire structure must be at least six feet tall including the length buried into the ground.

For stability the post must be set into the ground with concrete.
Wood material should be exterior grade such as pre-treated lumber. (Alternate materials such as wood composites may be used provided the mailbox structure meets all dimensional and style requirements outlined above.)
