# SILVER CREEK PERIMETER FENCE UPGRADE



The need to replace portions of our perimeter fence has been identified. The fence is located behind the homes run along Hite Creek. It separates our property from LG&E and neighboring subdivision Hickory Hollow. We began budgeting for the fence project in 2019. We are currently in the process of receiving bids from local fence contractors.

The length of the perimeter fence is approximately 2,300 linear feet. The project will be broken up into stages with the fence dividing Hickory Hollow and Silver Creek being the priority. The LG&E fence will be replaced in stages as well due to it being twice as long as the Hickory Hollow fence.

# **BOARD MEMBERS NEEDED**

Even with the new additions to the team, we still have open positions on the Silver Creek Homeowners Association Board.
