

Mailbox Standards

Silver Creek Subdivision Residents' Association

US Post (502-245-0087) should have our Subdivision requirements but in case they don't, here are our mailbox standards.

Mailbox, paper box, and all support structure must be black in color.

The Mailbox is a standard US metal mailbox.

Paper box is made from 1" x 8" wood material.

Post is 4" x 4" x 6' wood material 13" inches long.

The paper box width is 6", height is 9", and length is 18"

Measurement from the top of the paper box to the top of the post is 14.5 "

Measurement from the top of the paper box to the street the measurement must be 45" – 50" in height.

The entire structure must be at least six feet tall including the length buried into the ground.

For Stability the post must be set into the ground with concrete.

Wood material should be exterior grade such as pre-treated lumber.

Alternate materials such as wood composites may be used provided the mailbox structure meets all dimensional and style requirements outlined above.
