COVID-19 Rules & Recommendations

Kampground Facilities

- Upon arrival, please check-in outside the camp store. The reservations desk inside the office is closed and moved to the front window area.
- Our camp store is currently closed, but there will be limited items available for order through check-in window.
- Restrooms will be open and are cleaned several times daily
- The pool, rec room, archery, volleyball, and basketball court are open
- The playground is closed until further notice

Personal Responsibilities

- Running, walking, and biking are permitted while practicing social distancing
- Enjoy campfires & s'mores at your designated site's fire ring
- You must have a working bathroom in your RV as we will have limited bathroom capacity
- Practice social distancing by maintaining at least 6 feet distance from others.
- Please bring a mask with you. All guests must wear masks within 6ft of others.
- Wash your hands with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer frequently.
- If you feel sick prior to arrival or have a temperature over 100.4, please stay home.
- While at the park, make sure that a car tag is visibly displayed in all vehicles.
- Max 10 people per site.
- No day camp passes available.
- Visitors are allowed at your site, but must check-in with the office.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Use a disposable tissue to cover a cough or sneeze.
- Avoid touching your face, especially your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects.

Enhanced Cleaning Protocol

We have elevated our sanitation measures to ensure the well-being of our guests and staff by increasing the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting areas including but not limited to:

- Door handles
