

BEST OF SCOTLAND PRE TRIP ORIENTATION

- **TUESDAY:** Dress for hiking around Edinburgh as we will have a few hours before our rooms are ready (about 3:00PM). No trekking poles needed and no access to your luggage until we check in. [TIME: Scotland is 5 hours ahead of EDT]
- MONEY: The least expensive way to obtain Scottish money is at Scottish ATM's (Cashpoint), Banks or post offices. The most expensive is at the airport.
- CASH: I suggest ordering £500 at your local bank before you leave. [Exchange rate is about \$1.29 per £1.00 and note that the Scottish Pound and the British Pound are interchangeable, both are Pound Sterling with the same value.]
- **CREDIT CARDS:** Inform your credit card companies of your travel plans in advance. Check to be sure they do not charge a fee for foreign transactions.
- MAPS: I highly recommend getting the All Trails app for maps of our Scotland hikes. It really works well!
- **COPIES:** Pack copies of your passport photo and signature pages, front and back of your credit and medical cards and keep separate from your passport.
- **ELECTRICAL:** Obtain a US to UK adapter for your chargers and devices Check to be sure the voltage range goes to 240v. [You'll find more details on my website Travel Tips page]
- **COFFEE & WAKE UP:** Bring a reliable alarm clock and some instant coffee.
- **EXTRA SHOES:** Consider bringing a pair of old but sturdy shoes for use in boggy and wet conditions.
- **STREETS:** Look right as well as left when crossing a road or street.
- Consider bringing a swim suit, umbrella and two way radio.
- Bring a warm sweater (Wool is best).
- **PARK FEES:** Cairn Stone will handle all park fees and the admission to *Urguhart* Castle. Any other attractions such as Edinburgh Castle is your choice and a personal responsibility.
- ETA (Electronic Travel Authorization) You can't board the plane without one. Details on the Scotland page of my website.
- Special thanks to Cairn Stone vet, Linda Diehl for her assistance with lodging.
