## OUR ROAD WARRIORS DISPLAYED GOOD HUSTLE AT LOVE CREEK!



GRAND MERE: Our next hike will be this Saturday, January 25 at Grand Mere State Park near Stevensville. We'll meet at North Lakes Park and hikes will start at 10:00AM with distances ranging from 6.4 (low level elevation gain) to 15.7 miles. With the challenging hikes of Scotland fast approaching it is important for me as a coach to get in some challenging hilly courses in our training.

When it comes to hiking in Scotland two words come to mind; ASCEND and BOG! It's a beautiful country but you have to be ready for their breathtaking hikes. Saturday's weather forecast is clear with a high of 32°. Less challenging hikes distances are available for those not training for the elite hikes in Scotland. I can advise of several course modifications.

DIRECTIONS: North Lake Park, 3600 Grand Mere Road, Stevensville, MI. (I-94 exit 22, W 1,800') **REHYDRATION:** Round Barn Public House, 9151 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Baroda, MI (just 11 min. from our hike).
