

I chose the first time and that didn't work out so well. I am actually doing better taking care of three kids by myself than I was with my ex. Therefore, that is enough for me to say... I will wait on MY husband, and while I am waiting, I will continue living life. You only get one, you might as well enjoy it and all that comes with it in love or single!

The Beauty of Adoption

Throughout the course of my career, I've encountered several children in the foster care system and several who have been



adopted. It's been a consistent theme that I've only paid attention to in recent years when the Lord opened my eyes to see the beauty of adoption, and gave a me a better understanding of how the changes and beautiful beginnings that come from adoption in the natural are similar to the benefits and changes we receive through spiritual adoption in Christ.

The Spirit of Adoption is explained in scripture:

Galatians 4:4-7

"But when [in God's plan] the proper time had fully come, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under the [regulations of the] Law, so that He might redeem and liberate those who were under the Law, that we [who believe] might be adopted as sons [as God's children with all rights as fully grown members of a family]. And because you [really] are [His] sons, God has sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying out, 'Abba! Father!' Therefore you are no longer a slave (bondservant), but a son; and if a son, then also an heir through [the gracious act of] God [through Christ]."

This verse explains that the Spirit of Adoption has been provided for us through Christ, that God sent his Son to redeem, or "buy," us back from sin and death and adopt us into God's family by faith.

There's a spirit, or mindset, that opposes the Spirit of Adoption: the orphan spirit. An orphan is one who has lost both parents; one who is not part of a system, isolated, and abandoned. When we don't accept, or fully understand, God's love for us, it can leave us operating in a performance mode versus a grace mindset where we try to earn God's love and grace instead of simply accepting it as the free gift that it is. This is one way the orphan spirit manifests. As sons and daughters, we are longer slaves working to earn a master's approval, like orphans, we are children of the King who already have it!

There are 4 points regarding our spiritual adoption that I'd like to discuss:

1. We Were Chosen and Greatly Wanted:

To adopt means to choose or take as one's own by selection. In the natural (the physical world we can see), those who choose to adopt are not just given or handed any random child but one they've chosen for themselves, one they've decided upon in advance before the paperwork and adoption process starts

Ephesians 1:4-5

"Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure."

Before the foundations of the world, he chose us; He had made up his mind about us even then. He did all of it in advance. The previous verse (Galatians 4:4-7) says that in God's plan it happened; when the proper time had come, he then sent Christ. The prophecy of a Savior being born into the world by the prophets, and the time that passed until his arrival, was OUR paperwork "process!"

The word says it gave him great pleasure to adopt us, that it was what he wanted to do. No one is ever forced to adopt! In the natural, it's an extensive process that sometimes take years. You do it <u>willingly</u>. No one goes into it without a true desire to get the child. So, God didn't take choosing us lightly. He didn't take putting his Son on the cross for us lightly!

2. We Were Given Stability and an Opportunity for Intimacy:

There have been times I would begin therapy with a child in foster care, who has not yet been adopted, and the next week they would need to be discharged because they are no longer with that foster parent, moved to another home. This is not uncommon for children who have not been adopted. They are often tossed here and there; there's no stability or settling for them. When we were adopted, we were given a Rock, Christ. He became the <u>Anchor</u> for your souls, and a Foundation on which we can stand.

Colossians 2:6-7

"And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him"

For a tree, having deep roots means stability and nourishment. We are encouraged, and given the opportunity, to grow roots in Christ, which gives us a stable place to abide or live. In him, we now have a home. Stability is a prerequisite to intimacy.

Our key verse mentions our hearts crying, "Abba Father." Abba is an Aramaic word little children used to address their fathers informally. When you talk to someone informally, it shows you know them and signifies intimacy. We have an invitation, an opportunity, through Christ to build intimacy with God as his sons and daughters.

3. Our Conditions Were Improved:

Children in the foster system are sometimes placed there because of conditions of neglect (ie malnutrition) and abuse. Before Christ, our

souls were in these same conditions, spiritually!

Ezekiel 16:4-7 can be used to describe our former spiritual condition. In this verse, God is confronting Jerusalem who had turned away from him by describing, through a metaphor, the state in which he found them. I want to use it to look at our condition before our adoption through Christ:

"On the day you were born, no one cared about you. Your umbilical cord was not cut, and you were never washed, rubbed with salt, and wrapped in cloth. No one had the slightest interest in you; no one pitied you or cared for you. On the day you were born, you were unwanted, dumped in a field and left to die. But I came by and saw you there, helplessly kicking about in your own blood. As you lay there, I said, 'Live!' And I helped you to thrive like a plant in the field"

What is he saying here? I found you in your mess, without a safe place. He found us kicking helplessly in our "blood" headed for death. Before Christ, there was no help or hope for our souls.

I've witnessed children gain weight and begin to thrive as a result of being placed in caring environments. This is what happens to us, spiritually. We can now thrive; we now have improved spiritual conditions. We are washed by his blood and given his righteousness. He said to us, "live," giving us life through his Son!

4. We Were Given Full Legal Rights as a True Child:

In order to understand this, we have to grasp the fact that the spiritual realm operates as, or can be likened to, a legal or court system. What do I mean by that? There are meetings held in Heaven and there are such things as legal rights, spiritually, just like we have legal rights in the natural. God is frequently likened to a righteous judge in the bible and I've heard Christ referred to as a lawyer who pleads our case before God.

When you're adopted in the natural, your last name is changed through the court system, and you are given the same legal rights a biological child of your adoptive parents would have. Our key verse in Galatians said we who believe might be adopted as sons, as God's children with all rights as fully grown members of a family. When we were adopted into God's family, we were given ALL the legal rights of a son/daughter of God through Christ.

What are some of your rights? When Christ was raised from the dead, he was seated at God's right hand and placed over every power, ruler, and authority. His name was placed above all! That was the legal right given to him by God. And the enemy must submit to his name because of his legal authority.

Christ then gave us authority over the enemy. That is the only reason we can cast out demons and trample on snakes and scorpions, because we have the spiritual authority, or legal rights, to do so.

Ephesians 1:3

"All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ."

When he was raised, he then sat down in victory! He is seated in victory, and we are united and seated in and with him. That is why we can walk in victory as well!

Thank God for Christ and our new lives in him!

Dear Mama

Q: Why does God allow bad things to happen? My friend no longer believes after experiencing a tragedy in her life. How can I answer her questions?

A: Wow, I can write a book on this one. I have been through so much in my 47 years. I have asked God these questions numerous times. What I have found out is that God's grace REALLY is sufficient for you. He will grace you through some of the toughest trials in your life. When bad thing happens, we have to look at the SPIRITUAL facts.

One, we go through because our ancestors may have done something to sin against God that there was no repentance for. Repent for the sin of your ancestors and go to sessions to get delivered, so you won't have to carry the weight of their sins.



Two, you will be persecuted for his namesake. Paul says it best in **2 Corinthians 4:9-12**:

"persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed; always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body. For we which live are always delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh. So, then death worketh in, but life in you."

Paul is telling us that "you got to be willing to take one for the home team because as you endure the persecution it grows Christ in you." They are growing pains, which ultimately is good for the soul. Also, **Romans 8:28** says:

"and we know that all things work together for good to them that love God to them who are the called according to his purpose"

So many have had a horrific year due to illness and deaths of family and friends from Covid and many other causes such as financial distress due to job loss and inflation of prices, depression,

and anxiety due to current events.

Although it was written over 2,000 years ago, the bible addresses all these distressing issues. **Psalm 23** (NKJV) is a great representation of God's love for us even in times of distress and death:

A Psalm of David "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. He restores my soul: He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me: Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies: You anoint my head with oil: My cup runs over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me All the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever."

Even in times of sickness, death, financial lack, and fear, God loves us and will bring us comfort if we seek Him. If we are His followers, we will dwell in His house forever when we breath our last breath.That is an awesome promise for Christ followers to stand on. The Bible also addresses the issue of finances with this verse. **Matthew 6:33** (NKJV) states:

"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you."

When we are obedient to God's commandments and seek Him, He will give us everything that we need!

Matthew 6:25-27 (NKJV) also states:

1 John 4:18 (NKJV) tells of God's perfect love for us:

Hebrews 12:1-2 (NKJV):

The Race of Faith

"Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."

I encourage all who read this to consider your own race. Are you actively pursuing the things of God, or are you sitting on the sideline watching others? Do you know who Jesus is? Do you know what He paid for on your behalf? Do you know how much He truly loves you? I encourage each of you to study God's word for yourself, talk to God, and ask Jesus to show you who He is. Then I Was Completely Set Free! Deliverance Testimony

(This deliverance took place on 9/20/22)

The first demon that came up was named Hamlal. His legal right was a blood oath my dad made with Shiva. It was linked to the eye of Shiva. My right eye kept twitching on and off the entire session. It's linked to witchcraft because the demon thought he could try to control what Pastor Mark was doing by twitching my right eye. Pastor Mark asked why Hamlal was there. He said jealousy, overbearing grief, relinquishing, etc. So, Pastor Mark walked me through a repentance prayer for those things and for my ancestors. However, Hamlal still wouldn't leave so Pastor Mark tried another strategy. He asked to talk to the strongman over him. It was Lucifer. Lucifer didn't want to renounce the curses that he placed on me and my future generations.

Pastor Mark had to become creative with his torturing strategies because it seemed as if all the dismembering tactics, clock-ticking, flesh-eating mites, etc. weren't enough torture to get Lucifer to renounce the curses. So, he had dragons come in and "violate" him. There about 500 Dragons in line to engage this foul spirit, if need be.

After multiple violations, he eventually started saying the renunciations, but refused to say certain parts. He didn't want to renounce the curse of the mute demonic spirit in Lila because he said Lila is prophetic. Pastor Mark said, "Really? You're afraid a 3-year-old will destroy your kingdom?" Lucifer said, "Possibly... maybe... she knows too much."

(Pastor Mark also asked Lucifer if he knew the demon's name who is responsible for the mute demonic spirit in Ezra. The names weren't clear. I heard Mollach and Maniathan. I was confused because the second name sounded a lot like Leviathan. I think Lucifer sent confusion to me so I wouldn't hear the exact name, but they definitely began with the letter "M".)

Then Pastor Mark asked Lucifer the number of witches, demons, and demonic kingdoms he had under him. At first, the numbers weren't clear either. I was looking at a spinning wheel (similar to those seen on Wheel-of-Fortune)



and the numbers would stop then continue getting higher and higher. We finally came to the conclusion of 849 demonic kingdoms, 22,000 demons, & 155,000 witches. All the witches left and 21, 445 Demons left, yet 555 remained. As such, Pastor Mark took us to the Courtrooms of Heaven.

Pastor Mark asked Abba for the death penalty. His first witness was Jesus' blood. His blood spoke for me. His second was Jesus' broken body. His broken Body spoke for me. Pastor Mark asked the Holy Spirit to have Abba open the Lamb's book of Life to see what he wrote about me.

So many demon voices were in my ear. They brought up my promiscuity and lust from the past. The demons kept shouting, "The sexually immoral shall not enter the kingdom of heaven!" I broke down and wept before Jesus. Pastor Mark reminded me that those demons were fighting for their lives and that I had to, too. He said that whatever they say, just repent to Abba and ask him for mercy.

Jesus said, "Forgive them for they know not what they do." He was referring to the unforgiveness and bitterness I have in my heart towards my family and others who sexually abused me in the past.

I said, "I don't know how to let it go. I just want to lay it at your feet." Jesus said he washed me clean and restored my body parts. He said he made me righteous and Jesus told me that he made my private area numb to sexual pleasure as a protective measure. He said if he didn't make me numb, I would've spiraled out of control even more because of me being exposed to molestation at such a young age. He said it was all a part of his divine plan.

Then the demons jumped in. They said, "How could a God who loves you so much allow you to go through all that pain?" And I remembered what Pastor Mark said about us all having free will. The trauma that was done to me is going to be turned around and used for his glory. Pastor Mark told me to rebuke the demons in my ear, but to use their own words to secure their fate.

All my life I questioned why I never felt pleasure. I questioned God for making me this way. I hated God for making me different. I felt like an outcast amongst my female friends. I assumed that because I never felt pleasure with men, that I had to be attracted to women.

Then the demons jumped in again. They said every time I questioned God and felt like I hated him, I committed blasphemy. I didn't understand, so I asked Pastor Mark what blasphemy meant. Then Pastor Mark told me to ask forgiveness for that. But the demons said blasphemy can't be forgiven. I kept getting distracted and taking my eyes of Jesus to listen to the demons in the background. Jesus grabbed my attention back and said boldly, "Stop looking for love in other people. Stop idolizing men. Stop questioning me. Stop doubting me. Fuel yourself with the word and worship. You know what you need to do. Go out and make great nations. I trust that you use your gifts wisely. I trust that you instill these teachings to your daughter."

Then, Jesus listed the four steps he told me in my last encounter with him for me to continue to be healed: "Obey my commands. Walk in faith. Lean not on your own understanding. Ask me to lead you not into temptation."

Then the demons were saying things like "Why do you trust her? She's going to turn back to her old ways!"

Jesus said, "She has turned away from her wicked ways already!"

I turned to Pastor Mark and said, "I just feel unworthy."

Pastor Mark reminded me that I am Jesus' daughter, his daughter, and Sig Rev's family. He said Jesus and him are in the courts advocating for me and that I'm already on the winning side.

Pastor Mark had to keep reminding me to say, "Yes sir" to Jesus/Abba so that I acknowledged what they were telling me. I was just speechless that he's given me all this responsibility. Then, I turned to Pastor Mark and said I think we're finished at the courts. I asked Jesus if the demons would be destroyed and he said, "*I will take care of them.*" And then I was completely set free!

Is Your Soul Bigger than Your Spirit?

So today I'm going to begin talking about some concepts I'm slowly wanting to introduce - to get us thinking about deeper spiritual concepts. I like to learn about different deliverance tools so that I can be more open to the Ruach haKodesh/Holy Spirit leading using me in that way.

While you may be familiar with a particular way of deliverance ministry being done, just know that whatever way The Ruach/Spirit leads with is approved. Humans are very complicated beings. If you aren't familiar with operating in the spiritual realms these may sound very odd & weird to you. But that doesn't mean the spiritual realm isn't constantly around us but that you just may be unaware of it.

For now, I want to start with this question: Is your Soul larger than Your Spirit? 1 Thessalonians 5:23: spirit, and soul, and body.

So, we are a trichotomy, right? We are more than just this tent of a body: 1) our flesh (Hebrew: basar), as we are also a 2) soul (Hebrew: nephesh), which has a mind, will, and emotions. But there is also 3) our human spirit (Hebrew: ruach), which is another part of us that lives in the spirit realm which also has a mind, will, and emotions.

So, let's do a quick review:

So, the Bible makes a little more sense when we read verses like this...

John 3:3

Yeshua/Jesus answered (Nicodemus) and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born from above, he is unable to see the reign of Elohim."

John 3:4-5

Yeshua/Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he is unable to enter into the reign of Elohim."

John 3:6

"That which has been born of the flesh is flesh, and that which has been born of the Spirit is spirit."

John 3:7

"Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You have to be born from above."

Everybody is aware of our body - and many people consider the soul - but most people don't know about or even care about that human spirit part of you - which could be argued is the most important part of you. It's the part of you that has the closest and most direct connection with Yah/God.



Our soul is the earthlier, immaterial part of us that is more concerned with things like earthly information like directions, Google, computers, FB, recipes, birthdays, etcetera.

Our spirit is the immaterial part of us that is more heavenly-focused. Our spirit was created in heaven before the world was created (Jer 1:5, Eph 1:4). Once our spirit came to earth, our soul was then born and joined to our human spirit. Our spirit doesn't get renewed until we accept Yeshua as our Savior. Our human spirit may be with us but at times it may not be as it's who knows where in the 2nd & 3rd heavens. Think about this: As you are sleeping, since your spirit doesn't need sleep, have you ever wondered what your human spirit is doing?

The best way for communication to happen is from The Ruach/Spirit to our human spirit and then our human spirit relays that info to our soul. That is the ideal, but it rarely works that way, or it may work differently than you previously thought. Well, why do you say that Noe? I hear from The Spirit. I'm not here to disagree with you. I'm just saying that either 1) The Spirit may have to bypass your human spirit and speak to your soul or 2) maybe at times you've actually been hearing from your human spirit and not THE Spirit.

Understand that the human spirit speaks a very different language than the soul. Our human spirit wants to tell us things that the Father of Lights (Jam 1:17) has shared with it that our human soul is not ready to receive.

Your human spirit may have been trying to talk to you soul for years, but your soul may have kicked your spirit to the curb. As you've heard parents tell their children, 'that's just your imagination" as we downplay that tool that Yah/God can use to communicate to us for more earthly intellectualism and logic.

When we feed our human soul with carnality and fleshly lusts, it has a much harder time understanding or even caring about the things of the spirit. **1 Corinthians 2:6-16** has much to say about this. You've probably heard people say when talking about speaking in tongues about how that feeds their inner 'spirit man'. Have you ever considered that our inner human spirit can do much, much more than speak in tongues?

We also have to realize that our human spirit can get defiled per 2 Corinthians 7:1. Many people think our spirit is perfect and spotless, but that's not true. I mean it sounds biblical but that's not really the case. How do I know this? Because I've had to deal with defilement in my spirit and I know of many others that have had to as well. Here are a few, but not all, related verses: Job 17:1, Psalms 51:17, Psalms 34:18, Psalms 77:3, Matthew 5:3, Isaiah 29:24, 1 Corinthinan 16:8, 2 Corinthians 7:13, 2 Corinthinans 2:13, Isaiah 61:3, 2 Corinthians 7:1, etc., etcetera.

This is a HUGE topic so there's much I don't have the bandwidth for in this forum. For now, just be aware that there is another part of you that lives in the spirit realm. I'll leave you with this - try communicating with your human spirit. Your human spirit talks to you in many different ways so don't limit yourself. You may even be able to see your spirit - but don't be surprised if it appears as a different gender than your body. Your human spirit will have different likes than your soul/body which may seem 16 a bit odd at first. It will probably take you quite some time to figure out what your spirit likes. Because if you can find out what environment it likes, your spirit may be more open to talking to your soul. Have fun with it but share with the rest of us if you get some good, juicy feedback.

Intimacy with God

Brothers and Sisters in the faith, God gave me a word as I was laying down and he woke me up the next morning continuing to speak. He said that he desires to have a relationship with all his children, but that intimacy doesn't look the same way with each one. It's not a cookie cutter intimacy with God, because he made us all unique. Yes, we may have some similarities, but we are made different.

So, he was saying that how intimacy looks with one of his children, it may not look the same way with another. He says this is where PRAISE REPORT | ISSUE 10 his children are getting lost because they see a man or a woman of God that has a close relationship with him and automatically, they tell themselves whatever they did to get their relationship with God, to get that power, to get that authority, they must do the same thing, they have to follow that same blueprint. And God is saying, *"Son, that grieves my heart because I made all my children unique."*

It's similar to earthly parents. People that have children, you know that, yes, you love all your children, it's not one that you don't love, but your approach to your parenting, your approach to how you convey that love to each one of them is different, because their personalities are different. It's the same thing with the Father.

You also must consider that what a person may have done to cultivate their intimacy with God may not be the route that God wants you to take. There are many different variables for that, but here are a few that God highlighted me:

The person is giving their testimony telling you how they got closer to God, and you may be trying to follow that same blueprint, but what you may not understand is God desired for them to take another way to get closer to him. But because of their error, they had to go that way to get closer to him- because of doctrinal beliefs, because of what their parents taught them about God- but that wasn't the way he desired them to get closer to him, to build an intimate relationship with him. He said, *"I cause all things to be used for the*

good of those that love me, so that's the route they took." That's why it's important for us to seek him to find out the route that he wants us to take to be intimate with him. And again, God is saying intimacy with him is different depending on your personality. You just have to seek him for yourself and be careful not to follow every single thing you see a man and a woman of God doing.

I feel God telling me this: "I desire to show you a different way to be intimate with me, a way that doesn't have all the restraints of the world, that doesn't have all the religious restraints and the restraints of having to come to me in a certain way."

He wants to give you a less burdensome way of being intimate with him. God desires us to be intimate with him in a way that the world and religion would call "crazy," would think "that's not God."

God said, "This is why I haven't been able to use some of my sons and daughters in the way I want to because they're too religious. Their doctrinal beliefs, what their parents have taught them, was in error, and so I've had to fight and sift through that error to try to get them to a place where they should have been, honestly, years before."

He said his children are being left behind and he desires to get us to a place where no child is left behind. He left the 99 for the 1.

So, basically what God's trying to get me to convey to you guys is this that he loves us all, but the way that he loves us, the way that he $_{18}$ shows his love, may be different. So, don't try to get intimacy the way you see somebody else getting it.

I'm not at all saying that God doesn't put people in your life to be mentors. I'm not at all saying not to be teacher. But be careful not to become a carbon copy of the person that God has put in your life to be a mentor. That's not what God called you to do. There are certain things that God wants to give you through that person. You get it and you give that person due honor, but don't try to morph into that person; don't try to be exactly who that person is. God didn't call you to do that, and so when you're doing that, you're moving in error and you're putting restraints on God.

Because if it's something that that person does that God has not corrected yet, or that person has been hard-hearted towards and God knows he or she is not going to listen, you're going to follow and do that same thing if you morph into them. So, you take what God is feeding you from that person, but don't take everything they say for the Gospel. You need to study for yourself, to show yourself approved. You need to talk to God and ask God.

Sometimes God will give you something in your spirit like, "nah, that's kind of off," but you respect that person so much you just take it all in. But you do not know that they were taught error, or they errored all on their own. They have to take account for themselves in front of God when the day PRAISE REPORT | ISSUE 10 comes, but God doesn't want you to receive that error. God wants you to have your own personal relationship with him. No matter who is talking to you, go to God about it. Ask God to teach you how to get the intimate relationship that he desires for you to have.

God's going to teach some of the people in Significant Revelation new ways to get closer to him, new experiences. When you get ready to tell your testimony, people will say, "I haven't seen anything like that before." And it's going to be so simple and easy. People are putting too many restrictions on the Lord with their doctrinal beliefs and the error they were taught by their parents and/or taught by their church. God says, "Come before me ready to receive because I'm ready to give."


