Psalm 24:1

"The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein."

There's a lot we can learn about God by just taking the time to observe his creation.

Everything has a purpose and there is balance.

If we create an imbalance anywhere, it can start a chain reaction that affects other things in the earth. Nature is very complex and diverse, which makes it beautiful.

How much more are we a pleasant sight in God's eyes, who are also made diverse and unique from

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each other? When we come together in unity to serve Him, there's nothing that has a chance at stopping us.

Early one morning, I believe God gave me a glimpse of how a unified body of believers would look like. He led me to take a look at the Redwood Forest in California, and when I did, everything made sense.

The Redwood trees are the biggest trees in this country. They often grow over 350 feet tall and many of them can be 20 feet or more wide. These trees are giants, and it looks like they can withstand just about anything.

There's a big reason why they get to be this awesome and it's found underneath, at their foundation. You would think a tree of this stature would have a root system that reaches DEEP in the earth, pulling in a ton of nutrients to sustain itself. In reality, that's not the case at all. Their roots only go 6-12 feet in the ground, but what's unique about them is after that, they start to grow horizontally - reaching out to the tree beside it. As each tree's roots continue to grow this way, they intertwine and connect with their neighbor's roots. Since this is the case, each tree supports and nourishes the other. This makes them able to withstand earthquakes, storms, high winds, forest fires, etc.

I was shown that no matter what threat comes against a tree in that area, that threat has to fight the whole forest since every tree there is connected.

That's how a unified body of believers should look like in the spirit. Our roots should first reach down and be anchored in Jesus who is our solid foundation. After we get rooted in Jesus and his word, we need to reach out to our brothers and sisters- mirroring the roots of the Redwood trees. So no matter what the enemy may throw at us, individually or collectively, we have support on every side. If he tries to get one member to fall off course, he has to go through the whole body. Our God is forever undefeated; so as long as we stay submitted to Christ, which is our head, we will never be defeated.

Love and Authority

Early in the ministry of Jesus, He met His disciples and called for them to follow Him. One of these, Matthew, was a tax collector, and I imagine he wasn't well liked because of his job. Just prior to meeting Matthew and calling him into discipleship, Jesus healed a man who was paralyzed (**Matthew 9**). The people were amazed at Jesus' authority and His presence there brought controversy:



Jesus Forgives and Heals a Paralyzed Man

Matthew 9:1-8

“Jesus stepped into a boat, crossed over and came to his own town. Some men brought to him a paralyzed man, lying on a mat. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the man, ‘Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven.’

At this, some of the teachers of the law said to themselves, ‘This fellow is blaspheming!’

Knowing their thoughts, Jesus said, ‘Why do you entertain evil thoughts in your hearts? Which is easier: to say, ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to say, ‘Get up and walk?’ But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins.’ So he said to the paralyzed man, ‘Get up, take your mat and go home.’ Then the man got up and went home. When the crowd saw this, they were filled with awe; and they praised God, who had given such authority to man.”

The Calling of Matthew

Matthew 9:9-13

“As Jesus went on from there, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax collector’s booth. ‘Follow me,’ he told him, and Matthew got up and followed him. While Jesus was having dinner at Matthew’s house, many tax collectors and sinners came and ate with him

and his disciples. When the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, ‘Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?’

On hearing this, Jesus said, ‘It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick.

But go and learn what this means: ‘I desire mercy, not sacrifice.’ for I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.”

The Pharisees were the “religious” and legalistic people of Jesus’ day. They were offended by Jesus’ desire to spend time in Matthew’s home with those that they saw as undesirable. Jesus didn’t care about their opinions; He cared about salvation and healing for those who didn’t know Him. He demonstrated that He was sent by God through His miracles of healing and deliverance from demons. As followers of Jesus, we are called to do the things that He did. We are to love people no matter what, and He has called us to walk in even greater authority than He did while He physically walked the earth.

John 14:12-14

“Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. You may ask me for anything

in my name, and I will do it.”

If you are a follower of Jesus, I challenge you to step out of your comfort zone and to dare to BELIEVE what Jesus said in **John 14**! Pray for others in the name of Jesus. Love the unlovable. Have mercy for the lost and broken people in your community. Give generously. You don't have to go halfway around the world to be a missionary! There is a mission field in your own family, workplace, school, neighborhood, or even church. Study God's word for yourself. Read the words of Jesus, choose to believe them, and take some action. Your life will never be the same!

Dear Mama

Q: *I know my husband is cheating. We learned about Soul Ties, so I know that I am getting all of his and all of their demons when we sleep together. I don't want to divorce (God hates divorce) and have 2 kids under 5 years old. What should I do?*

A: Well, this is the story of my life, literally. My first marriage was a complete disaster, but I thank God for it (as weird as that may sound) because I have become who I am as a wife because of it.

Let me start with this:

The Bible says, let no man put asunder (separate) what God has joined together in **Matthew 19:6**. Please understand that God has not put together all marriages. We put together our own marriages and once married, we began to say God put us together.

We know God has not put together all marriages because the Word says do not connect with unbelievers in partnership/relationship, look at **2 Corinthians 6:14**. Paul clearly instructs us be not unequally yoked (connected to or in relationship) with unbelievers.

Psalms 1:1 says:

“blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stand in the way of sinners...”

With this being said, if you as a Christian married an unbeliever, God did not put that marriage together but He is honoring the marriage as the unbelieving spouse is sanctified by the believing spouse... **1 Corinthians 7:14**.

And let's be honest, if two people get married and neither is in Christ, we already know that God didn't put them together because God is already nowhere to be found in the equation. Therefore, we conclude that God has NOT put together all marriages and that myth has now been dismantled.

As far as divorce goes (if we are being legalistic), God says in **Matthew 5:31-32** Whoever divorces his wife, except on the grounds of sexual immorality, causes her to commit adultery... So, we see cheating, being sexual immorality, is grounds for divorce and it is the only stated legal ground for divorce. Therefore, this myth has too been dismantled.

Lastly, **1 Corinthians 7:15** states if the unbelieving (spouse) departs, let him depart. A brother or sister is not under bondage in such cases: but God hath called us to peace. From this we can conclude that God wants us to be in a place of peace and the spouse leaving brought just that: peace.

Now, just a little story of revelation:

There was a mother of three young children: 9, 4, and 3-years-old. She was brought up in the church and knew when she married this man that they were unequally yoked, but she got pregnant by him and was so “in love.”

Her family had a lot of generational stuff at play, and she was aware of their stuff: having children out of wedlock at the age of 21 (her mother, her sister and she missed the mark by two months). Majority of the women in her family had children by different men and she was determined to not be one of them (and this was on both her mother’s and father’s side). She knew from experience, and her other family members, that if the



father was not with the mother, then the children would not have their biological father(s) in their lives. Lastly, the majority of all her family members were divorced or never married (again both sides of her family). She was determined NONE of this would be her portion.

Being young, she honestly thought that she could pray her husband into the Kingdom and that her prayers would change him. The Word says that a saved wife will win her husband over into the Kingdom of God, **1 Peter 3:1**. She also witnessed this with older women in churches she grew up in and went to throughout her time in church (but this was not always as clear cut as this sounds). She was very determined “to do something different” when it came to her and her family dynamics.

Well, after getting married while pregnant with baby number two, the relationship took a turn. I’d be lying if I said it was a complete turn, but things just became blatantly disrespectful. She knew about soul ties and knew how they worked, but she just knew divorce was not in God’s will. That, and she did not want a divorce—mainly because she did not want her kids to have to go through what she went through as a kid. The funny thing is, when she was a kid, her dad cheated on her mother and had a baby while married which is what was the final straw in her parent’s relationship. Guess what; her

husband did the exact same thing, not once, but twice! The first time the young lady had a miscarriage, but the same young lady got pregnant again and had the baby the second time. The young lady still did not give up on the husband. She kept praying that God would step in and change the dynamics because “it was her responsibility to bring her husband to salvation,” or so she believed in her heart.

At some point, her honest prayers for her husband became honest prayers after God’s heart and His will for her life. She had been broken all kind of ways before marrying her husband and had “daddy” issues way before her husband came along. Because she was broken, she accepted what was presented to her and it looked good until she got caught up in it. The more she prayed and began to “seek the Kingdom and all of its righteousness first,” God began to do the work he needed to do on her. The closer she got to God, the more hell she had in her house, but she (her spirit) had gotten so close to God at one point that she experienced and lived in that peace that surpassed all understanding. I mean, even her husband came to her and said, “What’s going on with you? It seems like you are not here anymore. You just don’t care about anything going on. You are so nonchalant about everything.” He didn’t understand that she was literally resting in God, and she had cast all her cares on him. She no longer had it in her to respond or even think about what was going on in the physical world.

If she had, he would have been dead, seriously. Her mind had taken her to places that he could not imagine. At one point, she had even seen a body hanging from her ceiling fan- turning while she watched. (Side note: when the enemy wants your mind, things always began as just thoughts before they become actions.) She had been through so much with this man that her thoughts began to scare her, and she knew more and more daily that she needed God like never before. She threw herself into Christ, getting to know him and wanting to please Him more than anything in her life.

As she grew in God, the environment became more and more chaotic and unhealthy. She eventually came out of that place with God and that’s when things hit the fan and she put him out because she could not take the constant torment of, “Where is he? What is he doing? Who is he with? Am I going to catch something other than a bacterial or yeast infection?” The chaos became overwhelming and the two split; she snapped and put him out one day. She could not do it anymore. For the next two years, it was shaky. She was still determined to fight for her family, even if this meant from two different places of residence. The chaos ceased and she had peace of mind, at least sometimes. The kids no longer saw the arguing, fussing, and fighting and there were moments of peace for her. She stopped focusing on him so much and was able to deal with her stuff. It was now that the noise was silenced, and God was able to show her herself. This is where she began

to heal as God allowed a lot of self-reflection and dealing with the trauma and chaos that she had hidden deep down inside prior to high school and being interested in boys. She realized none of this was really her husband's fault, but it was her and she needed to deal with her stuff. Had she done this, she would have never married that guy! She realized she put up with all of this from him and it truly had nothing to do with what he was doing or had done. She was broken and hurt, and only knew broken and hurt in all relationships dealing with men in her life. She hated her father, and in turn, married him (someone just like him). She realized she didn't stay in the marriage after a certain point because of her kids or because God hated divorce, but because she was in a soul tie with this man and with the dysfunction and pain that she was familiar with. It was not until God came in, separated them, and was able to do the work on her, that she could see clearly.

One day, they had a marriage counseling session with a Godly couple that they had seen twice- but she had been seeing the lady alone on a regular basis to help with her own healing process. They had just seen the movie "Temptation"

by Tyler Perry; the ending was a little surprising as the husband walked away from the wife, and they did not have the typical happy ending of getting back together. In the session, she was still hoping for reconciliation until this very moment. The woman counselor asked the husband, knowing the background of him cheating (repeatedly, mind you) and the wife and husband being separated because of it, if he would have taken the wife back and worked everything out with her. The husband's response was, and I quote, "No. She knew what she was doing, and the consequences that came with it. But she chose to keep cheating and being in that other relationship despite the consequences." A light bulb went off and his wife looked at him, then she smiled. She looked at the couple and smiled as they looked at her somewhat speechless. The wife of the Godly couple responded, but honestly nothing she said was heard beyond that point. They gathered their belongings at the end of that session and left. The young lady called the couple after arriving home and told them that their services were no longer needed. Her husband had made it clear he knew what he was doing, and as long as he knew his consequences, he was fine with whatever they were. Crazy thing is, she still did not divorce him right then. They did eventually get a divorce, but she



had been completely beat down. Her self-esteem was shot to hell, literally, and she was broken. After her divorce, it took her 5 years of going after God and letting him put her back together to truly understand why her prayers for her husband didn't work. That young lady was me.

God showed me that He could not, and would not, go against the will of my ex-husband and he loved what he was doing; He did not want to change. To this day, he is still doing what he does with a totally different person he's married to. God showed me that was not who he had for me, but as long as I was stuck in religion, and not in relationship, for Him to do His work on me, I would stay in that place. A lot of times, we put up with things that God has not called us to under the pretense of other things and misunderstanding of the Word of God because we have other people's revelations and not our own. I am not in any way, shape, form, or fashion telling you to divorce your husband! I am telling you not to make the same mistake I made. I had made my husband my god, and that's all I could think about. I was constantly trying to fix something that was broken and causing me heartache. I had made him my god because it's all I could think about everyday until I changed my focus and allowed God to move in me and my relationship. I handed it over to Him, for Him to do His will, and He did just that when I gave him complete control over what I could control- which was me; He took over. My life turned completely upside-down. I lost everything to gain more than I had in

the first place, but it took me trusting God with everything for him to save me, my soul, in this way. His will for you may be in a different way. Give your life to God in total and complete surrender and allow him to lead you in what to do. I am going to say this however: when a man is cheating, he is putting his wife's life in danger. Be mindful of this when sleeping with him. Sex is the only sin committed against your own body, meaning the spiritual side is something to be reckoned with, but the physical side is nothing to ignore because you're looking at the spiritual. Please get in relationship with Christ and let him lead your decision regarding your marriage.

4 Characteristics of Hope

1) Hope Looks to the Future

Throughout the Bible, hope is defined as *confident expectation*. To expect, means to **look forward to**:

Ephesians 1:18

"And [I pray] that the eyes of your heart [the very center and core of your being] may be enlightened [flooded with light by the Holy Spirit], so that you will know and cherish the hope [the divine guarantee, the confident expectation] to which He has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints (God's people),"



In the midst of difficult situations, it is easy to ruminate on what is and make your home there. But hope believes in a future that is greater, or better, than what is currently seen. It is the possibility of "that which is to come" that hope holds on to. In **Jeremiah 29:11**, God gives Jeremiah a hope for the future, promising He had a plan for his life:

Jeremiah 29:11

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

The King James Version of this verse replaces "hope and

future" with "an expected end." Again, the word *expect* comes up.

2) Hope is Built on Faith

Previously, I did not relate hope to expectation, only to *want* and *desire*, with no guarantee, no real expectation, of what was desired actually coming to pass. I equated hope to empty promises, merely wishes. What I had was hope *without* faith. Studying faith and **Hebrew 11:1**, I learned that hope is built on a foundation of faith. Hope sees with eyes of faith that which is not yet realized and then confidently expects its arrival. That is why faith must first be established. A person without faith, is a person without hope. Hope expects what is not yet perceived by the senses. **Hebrew 11:1**, the beginning of the chapter of faith, explains this:

Hebrews 11:1

"Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]."

After first developing a platform of faith, we then EXPECT (hope) what is needed to come to pass.

3) Hope is Connected to Waiting

In scripture, hope is often mentioned in relation to waiting:

Psalm 130:5-6

"I wait for the LORD, my soul waits, and in his word I hope; my soul waits for the Lord more than watchmen for the morning, more than watchmen for the morning."

It is during the waiting that hope is challenged to manifest. As it says in **Romans 8:24**, hope that is seen is no hope at all, *because no one hopes for what they already have*. It's the

time between realizing what we need, and our receiving of it, that we must confidently expect. Hope sits between.

Hope deferred, expectation that is prolonged, makes the heart grow sick. Waiting is not always easy. Why can we CONFIDENTLY expect? Because the Word tells us hope in what God has promised does NOT disappoint or put us to shame. If it tarries, if it's prolonged, wait for it. You can confidently expect it to come!

Romans 5:5

"Such hope [in God's promises] never disappoints us, because God's love has been abundantly poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us."

4) Hope comes from God

Romans 15:13 tells us it is by the power of the Holy Spirit that we are able to overflow with hope:

Romans 15:13

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."

May the God of hope. God is the source of hope, and the Holy Spirit causes us to hope. Hope is no different than most virtues in Christianity (faith, peace, joy, etc.). It is His power that supplies us.

If you're in need of hope, the first step is to trust, to have a measure of faith. The Word

promises that joy, peace, and an overflow of hope will follow!

Granny Mae directed Shay to trust the Lord and to understand the meaning of this quote, "Et tu brute." The cryptic letter closed with the following communication:

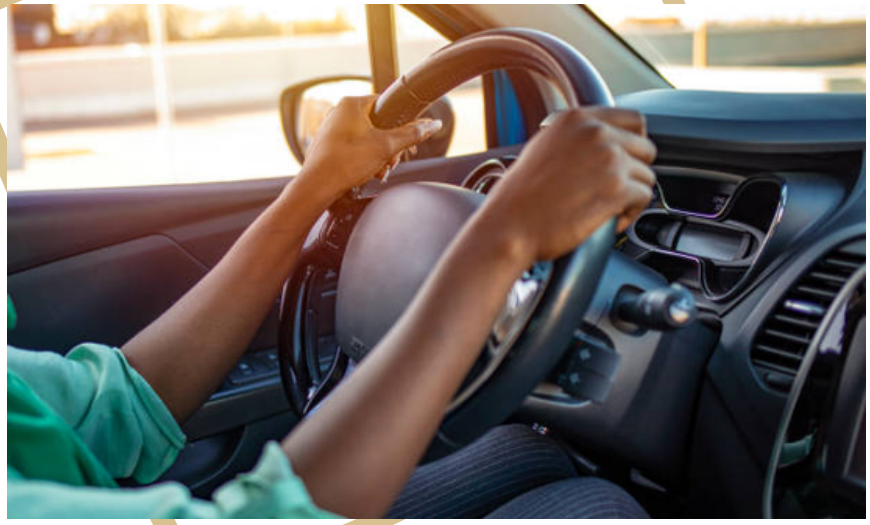

From the back of the trailer, an older man could be heard spitting flawless bars from J. Cole's, "Pride is the Devil."

Unfortunately, Shay discovered, as the two conversed, that this woman was able to endure severe bouts of narcolepsy and terrible gas, simultaneously. How Effective are Generic Prayers Against Curses?

The first part of this question is tackling the misconception that curses are no longer in effect after a person receives Yeshua/Jesus as their personal savior.

First off, let’s go back to **2 Samuel chapter 21**.

Basically, there’s a drought in the land for 3 years; King David is like, ‘Uhm, Father what’s the problem?’ Yah says, Saul killed some Gibeonites who made a covenant with Isrealites back in **Joshua chapter 9**. That is an interesting story, but I don’t have time to get into everything going on here. The main point is that even though the High Priest would go into the Holy of Holies on the Day of Atonement for the nation of Israel for the years between King Saul killing the Gibeonites and King David, the curse remained UNTIL David made a specific atonement. Hmmm, interesting.

Ok, how was that? That was easy, wasn’t it?

Not convinced? Thinking I'm doing some biblical sleight of hand? Well, if so, not intentionally. So, let's do this another way. First, I need to address a verse that is often taken out of context. This would be:

Galatians 3:13

“Messiah redeemed us from the curse of the Torah/law, having become a curse for us.”

Many people believe this means that curses no longer exist once we accept Yeshua/Jesus as our savior - and therefore they really don't see a need for deliverance ministry. However, if we dig a little deeper, and as much as I would like for that to be true, that's not the case at all.

To start, let's take a look at what the book of Acts has to show us:

Acts 8:13

“Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done.”

Yay! Simon the former-sorcerer/magician accepted Yeshua/Jesus as His Savior - **verses 16 & 17** alone could be another teaching for another day ;-). So, all of Simon's curses are gone, right?

Uhm, not so fast; if you keep reading,



Simon still has to work on his righteousness and the renewing his mind, as right afterwards, he makes an offer to buy The Spirit's power being used by the Apostles to heal others. I think everybody can easily agree that is a problem that he needs to change his attitude about.

However, if you keep reading, you'll find something VERY interesting:

Acts 8:22

“Repent, therefore, of this wickedness of yours, and pray to the Lord that, if possible, the intent of your heart may be forgiven you.”

Acts 8:23

“For I see that you are in the gall of bitterness and in the bond of iniquity.”

So, even though he received the baptism in the name of Yeshua/Jesus, Simon was still bound.

Keep in mind, Yah still believes in curses. Why do I say that? Because the curses He gave in

Genesis 2:17 and **3:14-18** are still in effect post-Yeshua/Jesus - even after He was crucified (**Rev 22:3**). We still die the first death, right? Whether you believe in Yeshua or not.

The curse of the Torah/Law is dying the second death as stated in **Revelation 21:8**. So basically, curses still exist. Those of you that have gone through deliverance ministry will easily understand this because you've probably had to deal with some curses - whether those curses were explicit (very clear) or implicit (not so clear or not directly intended - like they could be a result of some sin-action that initiated a curse without any type of declarations stating a curse is in effect).

So, the second part of this question has to do with generic prayers. Hear me out here: Generic prayer renunciations will only take care of generic, low-level, yellow-bellied, sap-sucking demons - those that don't have a strong legal right or case to stay.

On the other hand, those demons that have a strong legal case will not go away that easy.

Think about this - What if they did? What would we learn? If I sin and all I have to do is say some magic ritual prayer and, hey I'm good. So, in other words, we'd be using Yeshua as a "get out of jail free" card with Him serving us, instead of us serving Him. We'd be His Master.

Now don't get me wrong, sometimes Yeshua will take care of some deep-rooted issues very quickly and easily, but many times it doesn't work that way. There aren't many hard and fast rules in deliverance- meaning what worked in a deliverance session last time may not work next time. I believe that that pushes us more towards a relationship with Yeshua/Jesus rather than using some 'magic formula' or flow chart. Of course, we still have our favorite spiritual weapons that we like to use, but we shouldn't be surprised when they don't work.

Deliverance is a process, not an event. It's actually a way of life as the demons are always trying to get into us. I'm not trying to cause fear, but let you know of this reality. When you learn how to do deliverance, you get humbled quickly as you find out you really don't know that much and are totally reliant on The Spirit.

Think about it like this: When you go to a general practitioner doctor, he'll take care of general problems. For more complex problems, you need a specialist. It's the same way with spiritual warfare. Deliverance ministers work on having the tools to go deeper to root out the sin problems, as when you start thinking of all the sins you and your ancestors could have committed, that gives the demons a lot of access.

So, I just wanted to share this, as lately a few people have been believing that just because they believe in Jesus, they can't have curses.

I mean that sounds biblical, but when going deeper we can see it just really doesn't work that way.

I pray this blesses you.

This is an excerpt of the final sermon to those who were ministered to in Hawaii:

Over the course of the last several weeks, we touched on several things that may have challenged your customary belief systems. Many of you have witnessed healing miracles,

demons, witches, and warlocks manifest, as well as demons, witches and warlocks, ex-lovers, strangers, or those with whom you have soul ties, speak through you.

I have spoken to the Spirit of Religion, a Samurai who admitted to killing scores of people, the KKK, a witch who wiped out an entire community with some sort of supernatural bomb, Buddha, Allah, Loki, Jezebel, Pele, Kamehameha, Kahekili, Lono, Leviathan, Baal, Baphomet, a young lady who cursed someone to gain weight from googling witchcraft spells, someone who had 49 covens and a total of 7,000 witches in them, and someone else who saw King Herod, then Moses, and relived the Red Sea experiences. Even when the enemy tries his best to confuse you, if you are 100% honest, you will agree that all we say is, “Holy Spirit, you guide us. Holy Spirit bring up the one you want me to deal with. Holy Spirit you rule and abide. Holy Spirit you run the Show.” All throughout these sessions, these healing miracles, these 3rd Heaven encounters, it is the Holy Spirit that blesses people with these life-changing experiences.

The Holy Spirit is oh so strategic. You cannot out plan him; you cannot out strategize him. What I mean is that he has permitted me to minister to people who hear from the Holy Spirit. Go back

to your sessions, I merely asked questions and the Holy Spirit gave you the answers, visions and impressions and you enlightened me! Raise your hand if you heard me say, “Describe what you see? Ask the Holy Spirit, just repeat what he tells you?”

Think on it... don't let the enemy talk you into anything, better yet talk you out of anything. You sir, you madam, are, in fact, enthralled in a war. And the location of the biggest, most fierce battle exists between your ears. Come on Joyce Meyers!

By a show of hands, whose life has changed during these mighty moves of God? Look around... (raising hand). Who believes that Inner Healing and Deliverance, which Deliverance represents 1/3rd of Jesus' ministry, is vital to the growth, safety, and health of today's Believer?

Now, the next question is: what are you going to do about it? (**This is for you too SigRev.**) Let's look at a few scriptures to examine as we reflect on, “why you?”



Someone read: **Jeremiah 29:11**

“For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.”

Isaiah 55:8-9

“For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways My ways,” says the Lord. “For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.”

1 Corinthians 2:9

“But as it is written: “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.”

God has given you a gift... he has chosen to give you more of his supernatural presence. He has allowed me to align some of your experiences with biblical principles. Somethings, though hidden, were there in the bible the whole time, i.e., blood's ability to communicate, Jesus' desire to heal the broken hearted as it relates to heart-parts, fragmentation, DID's- you have seen the tangible reality of **Ephesians 6:12** in real time.

But now what? Am I talking to warriors? Studiers of God's word, people who like me (in the beginning) only want to know the truth-truth? I promise when I was young and was asked what I wanted to be when I grow up, I didn't say an Exorcist or Deliverance minister-casting out demons, battling witches, warlocks, and sorcerers- when everyone else was saying a doctor, a fireman, a policeman, no... this happened because I committed to doing what

the Holy Spirit directs. However, I can confess that there is nothing that I have ever done that is even close to being as rewarding this.

Within the last few months, I have ministered to 3 people battling thoughts of suicide and to see them flourishing today is utterly amazing. To see people's faces after they get some answers to many of the things that they have been faced with, things that have tormented and/or influence their and their ancestor's behaviors for years... it's an absolute gift. God allows me a front row seat to his miracles. I am blessed that he allowed me to witness a man, whose doctor said he would be permanently blind, see his wife for the first time, but he allows me to witness countless ppl, many here tonight, who have seen things in the spiritual realm that they didn't even know existed.

The night before I wrote this, I ministered to a person who was dealing with fear. The Spirit of Fear told me that the legal right was created several generations ago when an ancestor committed adultery; he gave the ancestors name. The mother and uncle were present and blown away because he gave a family surname from many generations ago and there's no way this young man would have known that! That one incident changed the limits of many onlookers' Christian Comfort Zones.... how can they possibly reconcile that? How can the Spirit of Religion talk them out of such a miracle? The Devil is counting on us being lulled back to sleep. God is my witness... a witch had the audacity to speak out of someone

and say that you will be gone soon, and he or she is going to return to their old life.

Listen to this one (and for those sharing, when you say that I am Crazy make sure you use a capital "C," like in Christ, and a capital "N," for Nuts, as in Nazareth). Check this out, Pele, a demon that many Hawaiians ancestors sacrificed babies to, told me that because of all the miracles that happened when we were here last September, that a coalition of demons was created to attack our family and specifically our baby, because of his anointing. She mentioned major Kingdoms in this coalition like Lucifer, Satan, Jezebel, Baal, Beelzebub, Leviathan and then she said that this "doesn't even scratch the surface." She mentioned that there were 100,000 demons and 40 witches from all over the world cursing this boy.

But now what? Am I talking to warriors? Studiers of God's word? People, who like me back in the day, only want to know the truth-truth? Who am I talking to?

What about people who would like to train to help others and then lead Inner Healing and Deliverance ministries in their own churches?

What about people who are just tired of getting their butts kicked by an adversary who was once in Heaven and forfeited his position and standing? You are literally getting your "you know what" kicked by a loser... I digress. Are there any here that would, at the very least, like to train to cast out demons, witches, warlocks, etc., in their own families and in their own households? Now, the Spirit of Fear
