Lord's Prayer

God desires a personal relationship with His followers. He sent us Jesus to be our go-between as we pray, and many of His followers haven't been taught how to communicate with God. It doesn't have to be formal and structured with repetitive and memorized prayers. Jesus gave us the following outline as He taught His disciples:

The Model Prayer

Matthew 6:5-15

"And when you pray, you shall not be like the [b]hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men.

Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward. But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you [c]openly. And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words.

Therefore, do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him. In this manner, therefore, pray:

Our Father in heaven,
Hallowed be Your name.
Your kingdom come.
Your will be done
On earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our debts,
As we forgive our debtors.
And do not lead us into temptation,
But deliver us from the evil one.
[d]For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.



For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses."

Prayer in public can be a very powerful thing! Calling upon the word and promises of God out loud can bring profound results, but God longs for us to have a personal and intimate relationship of prayer with Him. The Lord's Prayer was spoken to the disciples by Jesus. It is a beautiful and powerful prayer, but it is actually an outline of how God would like for us to communicate with him. Jesus spoke that we are to find a private place to pray, and we are to communicate with Him without using repetitive prayers. Instead, He has given us the Lord's Prayer as an outline to follow:

Our Father in Heaven, Hallowed be Your Name.

First, we are to start our time of prayer with

PRAISE. God desires our gratitude for who He is in our lives! He is our Creator, Provider, Healer, Deliverer, and so much more! When we start our prayer time like this, it is pleasing to Him, and it invites His presence into our prayer room.

Your Kingdom Come. Your Will be Done, on Earth as it is in Heaven.

Next, we are to pray for God's will to be done in our lives. God has a perfect plan for our lives, and as His followers we are members of His heavenly kingdom. He has plans for our lives, but it is up to us as followers of Jesus to ask Him what they are and to obey His leadings and commands from the bible. We need to ask that He intervene on our behalf so that His plans for our lives will be fulfilled.

Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread.

The next step in our prayer time is to ask God to provide for our daily needs. These are not limited to food! Our daily bread can be any of our physical, financial, or spiritual needs. God's desire is for us to acknowledge Him in prayer as we thank Him for providing for us and ask for our daily needs.

And Forgive Us Our Debts, as we Forgive Our Debtors.

Forgiveness is also a very important part of our prayer time. Jesus said that we must forgive our debtors (trespassers) so that we may be forgiven. If we are holding grudges and bitter toward others, we are blocking God's ability to forgive us and bring us peace of mind.

And Do Not Lead Us into Temptation, but Deliver us From the Evil One.

Next, we are to ask that God help us to avoid temptation, and to protect us when temptation comes looking for us. Many times, we are tempted to sin in some way long before we actually do it. Praying for God's help can prevent us from doing it.

For Yours is the Kingdom and the Power and the Glory Forever. Amen.

When closing our prayer, we are to pray like we did in the beginning! We are to praise God for who He is, pray that His kingdom be implemented in our lives, and thank Him for His Glory.

As we pray using God's outline, the Lord's Prayer, we will always see results. Take some time afterwards to listen for God's voice or to see if He is giving you a vision or plan for your future.

He may surprise you with something amazing!

Do You See Your Challenges as Growth Opportunities?

I saw a sign that said something like: "be nice to everybody because everybody is going through some type of challenge."

Some of these challenges can be big, some small, some quick, some long, some are VERY difficult, and others are so easy we don't even realize they are tests.

This is what life is in large part - as there is a season for all things (Ecc 3:1-8). Life is about ups, downs, and transitions.



Job 7:17-18

"What is man, that you make so much of him, and that you set your heart on him, visit him every morning and test him every moment?"

But it's the difficult tests that really cause us to question verses such as:

James 1:2-4

"Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have a perfect work, so that you be perfect and complete, lacking in naught."

Romans 5:3-4

"Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope" ...as our entire being fights with and hates going through these, because we like our comforts. I mean, I do, and I'm guessing you do too. I feel I'm pretty domesticated at this point. We like to feel good - however we define that - whether that's good for righteousness' sake, OR good for the enemy's sake - in carnal ways.

We have to realize that it's the tests in our lives that have affected and defined us in large part - for good or bad. Even personally, as each of us knows, there is the thrill of victory and the agony of defeat at the end of our challenges.

We all know that at some point there will be more tests in our life. So, I think it best if we can use these tests to our best benefit. This means that we have to look at the bigger picture by asking ourselves, "What is Yah's/God's purpose for this challenge? How is He trying to grow me?"

Our challenges are meant to teach us something OR perhaps even re-test us to see if we still believe or have maintained the same positiveness. Yah/God doesn't just allow us to suffer without being able to redeem that time (Gen 50:20). In one way or another, our challenges will bring Him esteem/glory.

Even as you parents know, in order for your children to grow up healthy and for their own good, you cannot live their lives for them. If you coddle them or baby them too much, they may turn out to be spoiled or grow up with a sense of entitlement. If you don't parent them enough, they will have another set of problems - which as an example can come in the form of addictions, fear, rejection, etc.

But we must understand that our Heavenly Father knows how to guide us through our challenges. Even if we did it wrong way back when, He can still make it much better for us if we allow Him to do that - to learn from the past and even heal that past. Many people think they are just damaged goods, but our Heavenly Father doesn't think that about His children. That's people seeing from their perspective.

The challenges that we have in this life are only momentary (2 Cor 4:17) even though they seem like they'll last forever sometimes. Yahweh's perspective is on your eternal life.

If we handle our challenges by the manner He prescribes in His Word, the Bible, then

He will see that He can trust us and reward us as He sees fit (Gal 6:9).

We must learn how to get Yah's/God's perspective on our challenges, friendships, life choices, etc. because otherwise it's like a child wandering around in life just asking for trouble. Parents know if their child doesn't learn how to overcome a particular challenge their life will be that much harder - for example, walking, talking, reading.

But as we get older our challenges are meant to draw us close to Our Father so that He can teach us to be more like Yeshua/Jesus.

1 Peter 1:7

"in order that the proving of your belief – much more precious than gold that perishes, and proven by fire – might be found to result in praise and respect and esteem at the revelation of יהושע Messiah,"

Even if our reward isn't immediate, we have to know that Yah/God is working things out for our good (Rom 8:28) and that He wants to share His Esteem & Glory with us (Rev 22:12) after our works have been tested (1 Co 3:13-15).

When we read Ecclesiastes, we see Solomon was focused on a great many things intellectually. Towards the end, he finally has this to say after saying that life is full of vanities or pride in a person's accomplishments or worldly pursuits:

Ecclesiastes 12:12-13

"My son, beware of anything beyond these. Of making many books there is no end, and much study is a weariness of the flesh. The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man."

The biblical faith and character that you are developing and using now are a much better retirement plan than a Roth IRA or a 401. Not that those are bad, but they aren't eternal (Mat 6:19-21). We need to focus on the things above (Col 3:2).
