We hosted our launch event at Memorial Park in Lordsburg, NM on November 5, 2021 to introduce our organization, our board members and our mission.

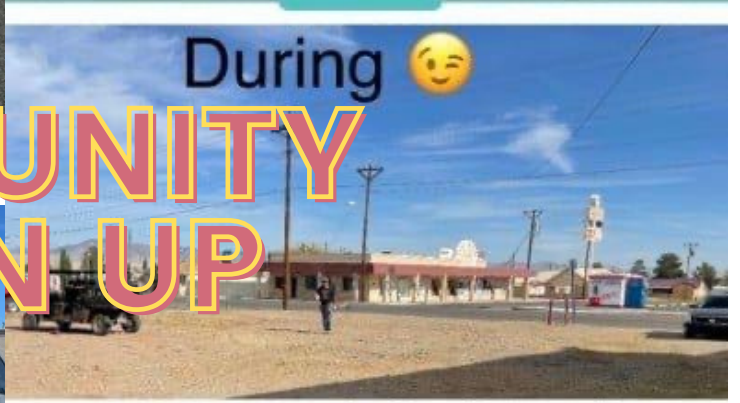
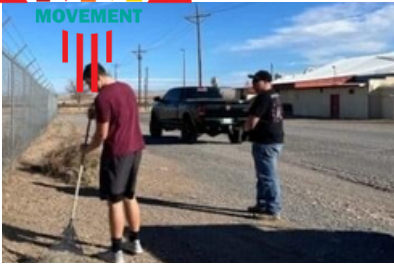
We initiated our first annual Community Clean Up event during our launch as we provided hot dogs and chips to our wonderful community members in attendance.
