

D1: SINGAPORE → SHANGHAI or HANGZHOU (□)



- Assemble at Changi Airport for your flight to Shanghai or Hangzhou.
- Arrive in Hangzhou, once praised by Marco Polo as "the most beautiful city in the world."
- Stroll along the historic **Southern Song Imperial Street**, rich in culture and charm.
- Visit the iconic West Lake, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of China's most celebrated scenic spots.

D2: HANGZHOU E WUZHEN (1.5H) (B/L/D)

- Enjoy a Grand Canal cruise and admire the historic waterway.
- Visit Xiangji Temple, Meijia House, Gongchen Bridge, and Dadoulu Historical and Cultural Street.
- Head to Wuzhen, an ancient water town dubbed "Little Venice", with riverside homes reflecting Ming and Qing architecture.
- Explore Wuzhen on a **traditional boat ride** through scenic canals.
- Special Arrangement: Overnight inside the Wuzhen scenic area.
- Note: No triple rooms or extra beds available in Wuzhen. Top-up SGD 50 for a single room upgrade.

D3: WUZHEN 🚌 SUZHOU 🚌 WUXI (B/L)

- Drive past Suzhou's Bird's Nest Stadium, the city's largest multi-functional sports venue.
- Visit the elegant Canglang Pavilion, a UNESCO-listed classical garden.
- Enjoy free time at Xietong Street, a charming blend of tradition and modernity.
- Proceed to Wuxi to visit Lingshan Grand Buddha and the majestic Fan Palace, often referred to as the "Oriental Louvre" for its grandeur.
- Explore Nianhuawan in Lingshan Town a lively area filled with unique shops, food, and a stunning night view.

D4: WUXI 🚌 NANJING (2.5H±) (B/L)

- Visit Nanjing Confucius Temple Qinhuai Scenic Area, one of China's four great cultural streets. Stroll along the riverside, admire traditional lanterns, and try local delicacies.
- Take a scenic boat ride on the Qinhuai River.
- Visit Zhonghua Gate, the most complex ancient castle gate in China.

D5: NANJING 🚌 SHANGHAI (3.5H±) (B/L/D)

- Visit the impressive Nanjing City Wall, built between 1366 and 1386 by 200,000 workers who moved 9 million cubic yards of earth to protect the Ming capital.
- Return to Shanghai. Explore Nanjing Road, Shanghai's bustling

- shopping and entertainment district.
- Visit The Bund, known for its colonial architecture and skyline views of Pudong.

D6: SHANGHAI DISNEYLAND (B)

 Enjoy a magical full-day visit to Shanghai Disneyland, home to popular attractions, thrilling rides, and Disney characters. (Only valid for weekday entry tickets, excludes The Lion King show.)

D7: SHANGHAI (B/L/D)

- Visit Chenghuangmiao (Old Street) for traditional snacks, crafts, and souvenirs.
- Explore the modern shopping paradise of Nanjing Pedestrian Street.
- Photo stop at the China Art Museum (exterior), housed in the former Expo Pavilion.

D8: SHANGHAI → SINGAPORE (B) or D8: SHANGHAI (□) HANGZHOU (3H±) → SINGAPORE (B)

*Remarks: The itinerary sequence is subject to change without prior notice due to unforeseen circumstances. The tour is conducted in Mandarin unless otherwise specified. This English itinerary is translated from the Chinese version; in case of discrepancies, the Chinese version shall prevail. Accommodation includes stays in local 5-star hotels and 1 night at Nianhuawan Deluxe Inn.

Compulsory Tours: (Shanghai Huangpu River Cruise, Tianzifang, Ling Shan Battery Car, and Suzhou LED Sky Dome) costs RMB 650 per adult and RMB 350 for children below 1.2m in height.

Please note that Wuzhen does not offer triple rooms or extra beds; a top-up of SGD 50 is required for a single room upgrade.
