The world is undergoing a profound transformation. While I remain the same, this rapidly changing world fills me with a sense of trepidation. I have long heard news of robots being used in factories, but the recent news that entire manufacturing processes are becoming automated strikes me with a mix of anticipation and worry. While products may improve as robots assemble them with fewer errors, I cannot help but worry that human jobs will gradually disappear. I also hear that robots are now even preparing food, leading to significant reductions in staff.

The prospect of adapting and living in such a changed world is simply daunting. Yet, staying still out of fear makes the future seem even more bleak. It was the same when I first encountered a cell phone. Because I didn't know how to use it, I only used it for making calls. Eventually, I learned to search the internet, use applications, and access my notes and emails from anywhere, which has been wonderful. Even though I barely use a tenth of the apps installed on my phone, I am satisfied in my own way. But now, another source of fear has emerged: **AI (Artificial Intelligence)**.

Next year marks the 20th anniversary of the founding of the Central Presbytery of the KOSIN Churches in America, to which my church belongs. While our denomination is over 40 years old, the Central Presbytery began 20 years ago, branching off from the Western and South-Central Presbyteries. As we began organizing the 20-year history of the presbytery, I saw how AI could organize data with incredible speed and accuracy. A fellow pastor, who is highly skilled in AI, is currently working on automating various tasks for the presbytery.

Through years of fellowship with this pastor, I felt challenged to dive into the world of AI myself. From the very beginning, I was met with fear. Even the terminology was so unfamiliar that it was difficult to understand. I am now trying to learn what tools to use and how to apply them. In doing so, I have found a certain joy in learning bit by bit. As my fear turns into joy, I imagine a great change will come to my life.

Fear of the unknown and the joy of gradual discovery always go hand in hand. Regardless of my experience, age, or knowledge, I hope to embrace both this fear and joy to take another step forward toward a better life.
