I fly frequently for various reasons. Depending on who sits next to me, the trip can be comfortable, or at times, uncomfortable. Once, a father sat next to me holding a young child. It must have been hard for the father carrying the child, but it was also very tough for me sitting right beside them. Held in his father's arms, the child kept thrashing around and kicking me continuously. It was a overnight flight heading to the East Coast arriving early in the morning, and because of this child, I couldn't get a proper wink of sleep.

Last week, I visited San Jose. On the flight back, an elderly, large-framed man sat next to me. Because of his large size, we had to touch arms, which was a bit uncomfortable. Still, it didn't disrupt my work. However, when it was time to order drinks, he ordered wine. A little while later, loud music began leaking out from his EarPods. Occasionally, he even moved his large body to the rhythm, getting into the mood. Until we landed in Phoenix, that unfamiliar music kept ringing in my ears.

Because you have to spend long hours in a narrow space with all kinds of people, flights naturally come with many anecdotes. There were people who talked loudly with the person next to them throughout the whole flight, a baby who didn't stop crying from takeoff to landing, and a time when I struggled because of someone's piercing odor—whether body odor or sweat.

In the past, I used to think, *Why are they like that? Do they really need to drink alcohol during that short time? Why play music so loudly? What are the parents doing that they can't get the baby to stop crying? Shouldn't people lower their voices when talking in a crowded place?* Condemning and judging every single thing, I felt resentful about how uncomfortable the flight had become.

However, as I flew more often and got used to these experiences, people's actions no longer affect me as much. It is because of the thought, "That can happen."

It is the same in church life. The church is a place where diverse people gather. Everyone lives with untold stories buried deep in their hearts. Because of this, words might come out wrong when least expected, or people might act in unexpected ways. This leads to people causing hurt and people getting hurt. I think it is rarely one-sided; it would be more accurate to say people give and receive hurt mutually. In times like these, I wish we had the grace to hold the mindset, "That can happen." Even if I cannot understand or empathize, thinking, *There must be a reason, there must be a circumstance,* I hope we can embrace it and move forward.
