

"My name in the book of Life"

During the past week, I spent time reading the book of Numbers. As I read about the offerings brought by the leaders for the tabernacle, I noticed something striking: whether the tribe was large or small, every leader brought the exact same items. The burnt offerings and fellowship offerings were listed eleven times—identical in every detail, except for the tribe of Levi. Before God's calling, there is no distinction. In God's eyes, every person carries the same worth.

Yet people often create distinctions for themselves. We assume that those who have more are more loved, or that those who achieve greater things bring more joy to God. If God has given someone much, then much may be required of them. But if God has given someone little, and they remain faithful with that little, then fruit will follow accordingly. Before God, what meaning is there in big or small, much or little? We are all His beloved children.

So why do we become discouraged or disappointed? It is because we compare ourselves with others. When we measure ourselves by the standards of the world, we begin to feel small, while others seem to shine. What we have appears less than what others possess, and suddenly our lives feel like failure while theirs look like success. In such a mindset, how can joy remain? Contentment disappears.

When I go to a buffet with friends and choose pork belly instead of expensive beef, I often hear comments. "Why eat the cheap pork belly when you can eat beef?" they say. But I simply enjoy pork belly more. Of course, beef is good too. But pork belly brings me more delight.

There was a time when I envied those who had much. I tried hard to accumulate more myself. But once I realized that those who have much also carry greater responsibility, I began to appreciate the joy of living simply and contentedly. Beef may be delicious, but choosing what brings me genuine joy—that, I believe, is the wiser life.

God has called each of us to this place today. In Scripture, some individuals appear frequently, while others are mentioned only once—perhaps in a genealogy or in a list of offerings. Some are not named at all, like the two thieves crucified beside Jesus. Yet when we realize that through faith in Christ our names are written in the Book of Life in heaven, that alone becomes a source of deep joy. And with that assurance, we can live boldly as Christians, no matter the circumstances.
