



"Law of Conservation of Mass!"

God has created the world we live in with order. When summer comes and we turn on the air conditioner, or winter arrives and we turn on the heater, there is one more thing we need to do. Living in a two-story house, we experience a significant temperature difference between the lower and upper floors. To address this, we run the living room fan—setting the airflow direction upwards in summer and downwards in winter. This helps circulate hot and cold air efficiently. As warm air rises, cooler air fills the empty space left behind.

When an empty space forms in our hearts, it inevitably gets filled with something. The reason God led me to the path of ministry was rooted in this very concept of emptiness. That void will always be filled—people use many things to occupy it, whether it be alcohol, exercise, or gambling. However, God guided me to fill that space with His Word.

In Luke 11, Jesus gives an example of a person from whom an unclean spirit has departed. When the evil spirit leaves the person, it wanders through various places seeking rest but finds none. Eventually, it decides to return to the house it left. Upon arrival, it finds the house repaired, cleaned, and in order. Seeing this, the spirit brings seven other spirits more wicked than itself, and they settle there, making the person's final condition worse than before.

We often make the mistake of thinking that once a house is repaired and cleaned, the work is done. However, an empty house inevitably deteriorates over time. When left unused, dust inevitably gathers. That vacant space must be filled—otherwise, as Jesus said, the final condition will be even worse than before.

The Law of Conservation of Mass also applies to our spiritual lives. We devote ourselves to various ministries and labor tirelessly. Over time, exhaustion sets in, and if we do not fill the empty space left behind, we may stumble. That space must be filled with God's grace and the Holy Spirit. For a healthy spiritual life, we seek the Lord's grace and pray for the fullness of the Spirit.
