We use the phrase "Personnel is everything" to mean that recruiting the right people and placing them in the appropriate positions is the very foundation for making everything go well within an organization or society. The same applies to the church. For a church as well, it is vital to discern the good spiritual gifts God has granted and to place them in the right positions.

We are now preparing to elect new church officers—specifically, ordained deacons (Ansu-jipsa) and senior deaconesses (Kwon-sa). Whenever the time for ordination approaches, I worry that some might stumble or become discouraged. It is only natural that the right officers must be established to build up God’s church in a healthy way. Therefore, we pray with anticipation for God's divine intervention throughout this election process.

What kind of people should become ordained deacons and senior deaconesses? What qualities should the officers have whom God establishes for our church? The denominational constitution outlines their qualifications: individuals of good reputation, sincere faith, wisdom, and discernment; those whose conduct aligns with the Gospel and who serve as models in their daily lives; and those who practice keeping the Lord's Day holy, attending worship, and tithing. In addition, there are requirements such as attending the church for at least two years and meeting a minimum age requirement.

When looking at these qualifications, some are visibly apparent, while others are not. Furthermore, because everyone sees things differently and perceives them to varying degrees, making a choice can be difficult. That is why the entire congregation must pray together. We must pray so that officers capable of carrying out God's work are well-chosen.

Those who have been selected as candidates for these offices should reflect upon themselves and strive to live a life worthy of the position. They must commit themselves even more to prayer, asking God to fill where they are lacking. Among these qualifications, I would like to focus on being "a model in daily life." All of us are members of the body of Christ. Therefore, as we build up this one body together, nothing changes based on whether one holds an official title or not. Everyone plays a crucial role. However, church officers must live exemplary lives so that other members can follow their example. They must not engage in actions that tear down the church, such as envy, jealousy, strife, division, factionalism, or gossiping. They must also set a godly example regarding alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and gambling.

We must all pray with one heart so that prepared officers—those centered on God, centered on the Word, and centered on the church—can be elected as models in daily life. I earnestly pray for God's guidance over our Valley Korean Presbyterian Church.
