



“Painting a picture!”

If someone were to hand me a blank sheet of paper and ask me to draw something, what could I possibly draw? When I first began ministry, I imagined myself drawing on a white canvas where nothing had yet been sketched. But the truth is, I lack the skill to express what is in my mind. I wanted to draw a beautiful church, yet I couldn't even depict a small window properly. The image I had hoped for never appeared, and I found myself staring at an unfinished picture for a long time.

While waiting for a dental appointment, I happened to watch a painter named Bob Ross on television. He mixed colors freely on his palette and began tapping his brush all over the white canvas. Then, with a painting knife, he scraped here and there, and suddenly mountains appeared, then trees, then a lake. What looked like random smudges transformed into a large tree by the lakeside as he moved the knife back and forth. As he mixed more colors and swept his brush across the canvas, a house emerged, and clouds formed. I watched in amazement as a beautiful landscape came to life, hardly noticing how much time had passed. When God created the world, He created it by His Word. But don't you think He already had the picture in mind before He spoke? Just as Bob Ross mixes colors and uses brushes or knives on a blank canvas, surely he has already envisioned the scene before the paint ever touches the surface. The canvas may be empty, but the beautiful landscape already exists in the artist's mind.

Although I lack the artistic ability to express the picture in my mind on paper, I now have a way to bring those thoughts to life without drawing them myself. It amazes me that if I describe my idea well, AI can create the picture for me. But to use AI effectively, I must describe the image in my mind clearly; otherwise, the result will not match what I envisioned. A poor description will inevitably produce a distorted picture.

So I want to first paint a beautiful picture of the church God desires—clearly, vividly, and faithfully—in my own mind. And then I want to find ways to express and share that picture with all our members so that we may draw it together. With this hope, I pray that our church will grow into the healthy, God-pleasing church He envisions for us.
