



“Fellowship of the Believers”

I recently heard a story about a believer who moved from a large church with thousands of members to a smaller one. This person had been deeply committed — attending worship regularly, participating enthusiastically in small group meetings, and serving as a Sunday school teacher. They were highly satisfied with their faith life, finding immense joy in worship and deeply appreciating the pastor’s sermons. They had served the church faithfully for years. However, one day, they missed church due to an illness. Though it was unavoidable, they returned the following week feeling a bit apologetic but determined to serve even harder. But when they returned, they realized that their absence had gone completely unnoticed. No one seemed to know that they had missed the previous week. They felt as though their presence didn't truly matter. Consequently, they visited a smaller church, where many people reached out, chatted with them, and made them feel genuinely cared for. This experience ultimately led them to switch churches. Our quality of life has greatly improved, which has led to the rise of many clubs where people with shared interests gather. Whether it is a cycling club, a golf club, a soccer club, or a hiking club, people come together to socialize over shared hobbies. Yet, simply sharing a hobby does not guarantee a deep connection. People’s hearts must align, and they need to feel comfortable beyond just the shared activity. Even in ordinary secular clubs, human relationships are incredibly important. How much more so, then, in the church? The church must be united in one faith and one Holy Spirit. Since the Holy Spirit dwelling within each of us is the exact same Spirit, being united should not seem so difficult. And yet, I have rarely seen a completely unified church. While churches may not be entirely divided, calling them truly "one" often falls short. People often say the strength of a small church is that it feels like a family. I, too, hold high expectations for a family-like church. Nevertheless, we still fall short of becoming a true family. Because the church is a gathering of people, jealousy and conflicts can arise. However, the church is a gathering of people of faith—those who are set apart. There are many ways to overcome conflict and strife: someone must be considerate, someone must endure, and someone must serve. If we can stand not as those who expect to receive, but as those who choose to be considerate, patient, and servant-hearted, wouldn't much of our shortcomings be filled? I pray that the grace of the Holy Spirit, who binds us together as one, will fill the hearts of all our beloved saints.
