



“Traces of Life”

My pastor friend went on a trip. It was about a month-long journey, and since he had no one to watch his cat, he asked me for a favor. He asked if I could drop by about once a week to feed the cat and check on how it was doing. Since I didn't have to keep it with me and it was only once a week, I figured I could handle it and gladly agreed. After my friend's family left and a week passed, I went to their house to check on the cat.

No matter how much I looked around, the cat was nowhere to be seen. I even started to worry that it might have escaped. However, when I checked its litter box, there were clear traces. The food had also decreased. I could see signs of the cat playing here and there. Thinking, "Ah, it's alive," I cleaned up after it. The following week, and the week after that, I still couldn't catch a glimpse of the cat. I simply trusted it was alive based on the traces it left behind.

There is a proverb that says, "An animal leaves its hide when it dies, and a human leaves their name." Embedded within the name a person leaves behind are the traces of their life. What they did, the path they walked, and how they were perceived by others can all be known through the traces they leave.

We see countless names mentioned in the Bible. Some left their names as kings, some as military commanders, some as prophets, and others as apostles. Some were remembered as those who repaired the temple, some as those who received offerings, some as gatekeepers, and some as those who rebuilt the city walls.

This made me look back on my own life's journey and reflect on what kind of traces I am leaving behind, filling me with both anticipation and fear about how my name will be recorded in God's Book of Life. The shameful traces scattered throughout my life move me to bow my head in repentance again today. Even so, I am deeply grateful that God called someone like me to be a pastor and entrusted me with the Church, which is the body of Christ. This fills my heart with even greater care and reverence. I truly hope that each of us can leave behind beautiful traces in the unique places of life where God has called us.

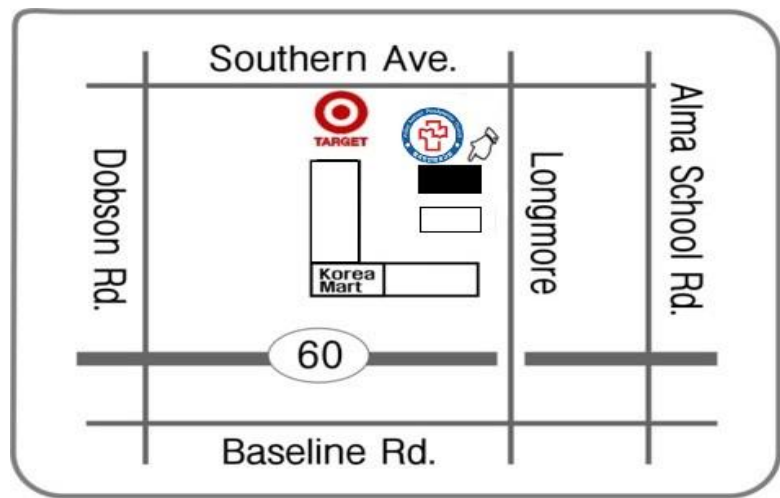

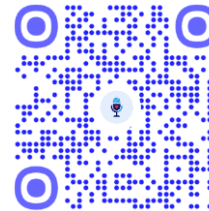
