While that hasn't happened with humans, such technology is already being used with pets. And even without implanting anything into our bodies, we now live in a world where our actions can be tracked in countless ways.

Although these technologies were developed to make human life more convenient, there's a growing concern that we may end up being ruled by machines instead. Nevertheless, even AI is one of the fruits of science permitted by God. That's why I'm reminded once again of the phrase Coram Deo—to live before the face of God with fear and trembling. It leads me to reflect on myself as I stand before Him.

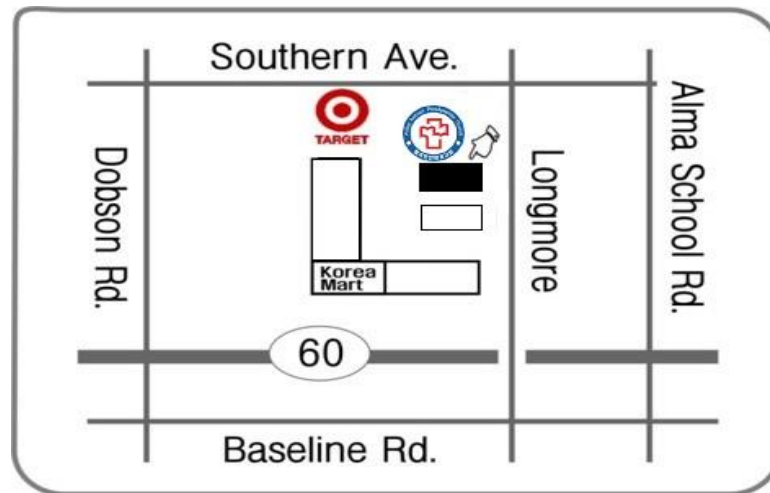
