We need to share His word. We must gather together to pray and sing praises. I hope that all of us can serve as one for the ministries God opens up for us—teaching, relieving the needy, volunteering, mission, and evangelism. I eagerly look forward to the new path God is bringing to pass at Valley Korean Presbyterian Church.

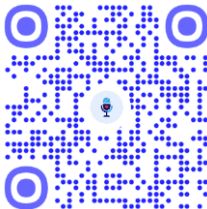
