Hope in the Midst Despair!

Last week, I attended the Navajo Mission Leadership Retreat. We spent time encouraging the missionary serving in Navajo, preparing for the annual summer school ministry, and sharing various stories about the Navajo mission.

Five years ago, we began a summer school in the Copper Mine region of Navajo through a denominational partnership. Over the course of six weeks, churches from various regions across the United States have been cooperating to carry out this ministry. What started as a ministry centered around one church in Copper Mine has now reached the point where there is a growing need to gradually expand both the work and the area it serves.

As with most mission work, while the mission field itself bears fruit, the churches participating in it have also reaped many blessings through their involvement. Without sowing seeds, there can be no harvest. When seeds are sown, one may gather abundant fruit or experience unexpected joy. The missionary and the participating churches are approaching this ministry with the heart of sowing seeds into a flowing river.

After ten years of ministry in the Navajo region, Missionary Hwang found himself in deep despair, once again reflecting on the Navajo people. Confronted by the pervasive sinfulness among them and the hopelessness of a future they could not see, everything began to feel meaningless. Doubts arose about the significance of the work being done. Yet, the missionary shared that he is gradually recovering, realizing anew that "God is the One who brings forth shoots from the remaining stump."

In every ministry that continues year after year, there are always crises that make it difficult to sustain the work. If these crises are overcome well, the ministry can continue; if not, it may even have to stop. The crisis facing the Navajo mission arose from within.

We faithfully obey the command the Lord has given us, diligently sowing seeds. The harvest belongs to God. This is true not only in the mission field but also within the church. At times, as we remain faithful to the roles and callings entrusted to us, we may face disappointment and discouragement. We may even question the meaning of what we are doing. Yet, by looking to God—who surely brings the harvest in His time—we can find strength today to press on.


