



“WE Must Be an Example!”

When I look out from the church office, I often witness interesting scenes. These days, DoorDash delivery robots constantly move back and forth in front of the church. I thought their months-long test run had finally ended, but seeing them again makes me think something must have gone wrong in their operations.

Students from the middle school down the street sometimes stop in front of the office window to fix their clothes or smile at their own reflection. At times, unfamiliar cars park in front of the office, and I wonder who has arrived—only to find, after checking, that they are simply people sitting in their cars making phone calls.

One day, a suspicious-looking car stopped in front of the church. It was a very high-end SUV. It wasn't parking; it simply came to a sudden stop. A young boy stepped out of the car. From inside, a woman—presumably his mother—said something to him, and the boy looked around nervously. Then, to my shock, he began urinating in the flowerbed in front of the church.

I considered running outside, but I didn't want to embarrass the child, so I stayed where I was.

Two things surprised me.

First, the lack of basic public manners. The street in front of our church is not a small alley. People walk by, and cars pass frequently. For a child to relieve himself under a tree on a main road shows a disregard for public decency.

Second, the mother seemed unaware of the impact her actions would have on her child. I saw the boy hesitating, looking around anxiously. He must have been embarrassed, he must have been in a hurry, and his mother was urging him on. There is a Target nearby, and even a McDonald's close enough—why make him do such a thing on the street? What lesson did this child learn from his mother in that moment?

As I meditated on Sunday's message, I was reminded that we are called to offer our lives as holy sacrifices to God. Our daily lives inevitably communicate something to others. Our words and actions always influence the people around us.

People of faith must speak differently.

Disciples of Jesus should radiate love through their demeanor.

People of prayer do not speak carelessly.

I hope that all of us—both within the church and in every place we live out our daily lives—can be a proper example of what it means to follow Christ. May our words, our actions, and the way we live reveal the love of Jesus in a beautiful and compelling way.
