



“As We Enter Holy Week”

It is Holy Week. As I prepare for this sacred time, I feel my heart grow still. Even the air around me seems to settle with a heavy weight. Before gratitude rises in my heart as I look to the cross, the scenes of the suffering our Lord endured come to mind. Perhaps that is why the vivid scenes from *The Passion of the Christ*, which I watched during a past Holy Week, have remained so deeply impressed on me. The cross on the pulpit has not changed, and yet during Holy Week the meaning of His shed blood seems to press upon me more intensely.

We cannot truly imagine the extent of the suffering Jesus endured. In the Philippines, each year during Holy Week, a person is chosen to reenact the scene of the crucifixion. They carry a large wooden cross and walk the path, followed by many people. When they reach a designated place, they undergo an extreme form of penance—being nailed to a cross or scourged—to experience, in some measure, the sacrificial death of Christ.

In that same spirit, we also fast and pray to participate, even in a small way, in the suffering of Jesus. We rise early in the morning to gather and pray. We refrain from media and from pleasures. By placing limits on our usual routines, we seek to meditate more deeply on the cross and to enter into the pain our Lord bore for us.

Throughout this week, we devote ourselves to reflecting on the Lord, remembering the meaning of His suffering, examining our own lives through the true love He has shown us, and reaffirming our calling to share the love of Christ with others.

Yet there is something we must not forget: this suffering is not meant to end with simply enduring pain. Jesus suffered to atone for our sins—and He rose again. As we walk through Holy Week, meditating on the way of the cross and the path of suffering, we must also fix our eyes on the glorious Christ who emerged after the suffering. Even when our lives are difficult, even when the pain feels unbearable, we must hold onto the hope that if we endure in faith, the crown of glory awaits us.

I pray that as you fast, practice self-control, and walk through this week, your life will be filled with the abundant grace that our Lord pours out.
