What sustains our society? How does God govern this vast world? We reflect on law, order, and exceptions. A society can be said to be stable when its members uphold law and order. When laws are disregarded and order is ignored, the result is nothing but confusion.

Yet, the question of for whom the law exists and for whom order is maintained is somewhat different. Law and order cannot become ultimate truth. At times, they serve the wealthy; at other times, they protect the interests of those in power. Thus, new laws are created, and some use those laws to pursue their own gain. Law and order, as spoken of in society, change according to circumstances and environments.

One may strive to keep the law thoroughly, yet there are times when circumstances make it impossible to follow. Thus, exceptions are introduced. Clauses beginning with words like “however” or “except” explain special cases that do not fall under the law. There are also those who exploit these exceptions for their own gain. This reveals how incomplete and imperfect the law truly is.

Yet God’s law does not change. God’s Word is perfect. God created this world with order. His order flows without the slightest error. In God’s plan, there is no lack. There are no exceptions. God is a righteous God. Therefore, He paid the price of sin by sacrificing His own Son. This is the love of God, given in righteousness.

It is good to refrain from criticizing and condemning others with imperfect standards. We must live with God’s Word at the center. The standard for our judgments and decisions should be God’s Word. Before criticizing and condemning others, we must first examine ourselves. May love for God and love for our neighbors always stand at the center of our lives. As I see my tendency to criticize and condemn, I once again realign myself to stand firmly upon God’s Word.
