the shepherd boy



In a certain village, there was a shepherd boy who tended sheep. One day, feeling bored, he played a prank by falsely shouting that wolves had appeared. The villagers, startled, rushed to help two or three times, only to find out it was a lie each time. Frustrated and annoyed, they began to grumble and scold him. Then one day, real wolves actually appeared and began attacking and eating the sheep. The shepherd boy cried out desperately that it was real this time, but no one listened. In the end, the boy lost all the sheep he had been caring for. This is a story from Aesop's fables. Words like "state of emergency," "crisis," "urgent situation," "temporary measure," "exception," or "just this once" immediately evoke a sense of urgency. They suggest that we must overcome the crisis by any means necessary, or that we're in a situation where we have no choice but to put out the immediate fire first.

The shoulder lane on the road is designed to be used in emergencies. But what happens when someone, frustrated by traffic, decides to drive on the shoulder? Emergency vehicles—those that truly need to get through—end up blocked. Everyone knows this. Yet many people still enter the shoulder lane because they feel rushed, or simply follow others who are doing the same. Words like "emergency" and "crisis" are used when situations are truly urgent. That's why we have laws in place to prepare for emergencies, and why emergency rooms exist—to respond to urgent medical needs. However, people often want to apply emergency laws even when the situation isn't truly an emergency. They cite a one—time exception as justification, and then try to create new exceptions every time.

Whether it's a nation, a community, or a church, there must be order. Emergencies and exceptions can arise, but if we recklessly dismantle the order we've established just because things feel urgent, it becomes very difficult to restore it.

Reflecting on recent events in the General Assembly, presbyteries, and our surrounding communities, I find myself deep in thought. God created the world through His Word and placed us in it to live. I believe that living wisely means honoring and upholding the order that God has established.


