



“Walking With Jesus”

Through the various events and incidents that unfold each day, I often find myself taking time to reflect on my own heart. Even today, as I watched a car cut in front of mine, I quietly muttered to myself. A hint of irritation almost slipped out, but I corrected my thoughts, telling myself, “They must be in a hurry for some reason.” After all, the driver who suddenly swerved ahead of me has no idea that I’m upset, and if I choose to be a little more gracious, my own heart will be far more at peace.

When will I be able to live as a truly mature Christian? Accepting Jesus as our Savior and walking with Him can feel especially difficult to grasp when life becomes challenging. There is someone I think of whenever I begin to wonder whether Jesus is truly with me in my daily life.

Tolstoy describes his transformation in his writing *“My Confession”*:

“Five years ago, I truly accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord. Then my whole life changed. I no longer desired what I once desired, and instead I began to long for things I had never sought before. What once seemed good no longer appeared good, and what once seemed insignificant now appeared important.

I had been chasing what people call the rainbow of fortune, but I came to see its emptiness. Pretending to be something I was not, sexual indulgence, and the pleasure of drunkenness could no longer be considered happiness.”

He was saying that meeting Jesus marked the beginning of a new life. And the starting point of that new life is the truth that Jesus is always with us. Tolstoy once shared a fable that illustrates this beautifully. In a conversation among fish about water, an old fish said:

“What we live in is water. Water is, in a sense, our very life. Our whole bodies are constantly immersed in it, and we live in it every day. That is why we neither feel it nor even think about it.”

In the same way, we often fail to recognize the Jesus who is always with us, and because of that, we miss the peace He longs to give. As we prepare for the Holy Week early morning prayer meetings, I am grateful for the moments that help us rediscover the presence of Jesus who walks with us.
