



"The Church with a Collapsed Roof"

There is a church with a collapsed roof that I see whenever I leave my house to go to my own church. It used to be a beautiful church with a spacious yard, but at some point, it was left standing with its roof caved in, creating a bleak and unpleasant sight. When I first saw it, I would pass by with simple thoughts: How did the roof collapse? Was anyone hurt? I hope it gets fixed quickly.

However, as time passed and the church remained completely unchanged, I began to feel somewhat bewildered. I wondered if the aftermath of the accident wasn't being handled well, or if negotiations with the insurance company had stalled. Yet, even after several years, it remains in the exact same state. Only the skeleton of the roof is left, and only the side walls that didn't collapse manage to hold their shape.

It is quite rare to see a church building practically collapsed like this. Usually, ruined buildings are rebuilt in no time. The fact that this church has not been rebuilt even after several years suggests there must be a serious underlying problem.

Beyond physical church buildings, we often witness many "collapsed" churches in a spiritual sense. I have seen a church with thousands of congregants dwindle to just a few dozen overnight. I have seen a church renowned for its revival shrink into a small congregation before anyone noticed. Of course, I have also seen churches close their doors entirely for various reasons. It is truly heartbreaking.

There may be various practical reasons why the church with the collapsed roof cannot readily stand back up. However, I see it differently. It seems that when the roof collapsed, the believers who were fulfilling their roles there collapsed along with it. When the members of a church collapse, recovery becomes difficult. This is a different story from the church's foundation being shaken.

The church is an organic community. It is a place built up by believers who each fulfill their respective roles. Some must act as the hands, while others act as the feet. Some must see with the eyes, and others must express with the mouth. A church becomes healthy when everyone fulfills their role well. Sometimes there are deficiencies. While someone might temporarily step in to cover that role, no one can handle everything alone. That is why the Bible emphasizes one body, one Spirit, and one faith.

May You grant us a beautiful, unified community where we faithfully fulfill our given roles as one.
