Today, we honor the grace of our parents. In immigrant ministry, many of us feel like "filial sinners," unable to visit home as often as we should. This day calls us to look inward before we speak of honoring others.

Reflecting on Noah and the teachings of Paul, we see that the parent-child bond is not about "absolute obedience," but a covenant of love established by God. When this divine order collapses, families and society follow. We often dwell on the wounds we've received while easily forgetting the hurts we've caused others—a subtle consequence of sin in our lives.

Whenever Christian holidays or special Sundays come around, we remember God's love. We take time to be grateful for the immense grace He has bestowed upon us. Mother's Sunday is the same. I hope this can be a time where we lay everything else down and simply give thanks while reflecting on the love we have received.

I recently saw a heartwarming and humorous video of a mother singing a celebratory song at her daughter's wedding, moving the audience between laughter and tears. The lyrics go like this:

> "I thought I had only closed my eyes for a moment, but I was already old. I thought you would always be a little child, but you are already getting married. I still don't know much about life, so I have no grand words of wisdom for you, but because I want you to be a little happier, I search deep within my heart for something to say.

> **Pray.** God will be with you. **Love.** Each other exactly as you are. **Be together.** Having lived through it, I realize that is what matters. Live your own life.

> I loved the sight of you chattering away after coming home from school. Do you remember those 'crazy' puberty years? Back then, I felt like I could just... well, never mind! You always did your best in everything, so you were always our pride. My lovely [Name], our gift—I was so happy because you were my daughter.

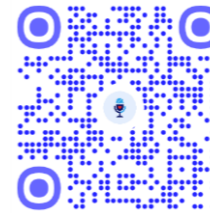
