I started wearing glasses when I was in middle school. I still remember the day I went to the optician, had my eyes examined, and put on my first pair of glasses. At first, it felt as if the whole world was shaking. Everything looked distorted. But gradually, as things came into focus, I was introduced to a new world. Things I had never seen before began to appear. Even the tiny specks of dust dancing in the sunlight became visible. I loved that clear, vivid world.

These days, I use four different pairs of glasses. One is for everyday life—designed to help me see both near and far with clarity. Another is for driving, especially to shield my eyes from sunlight. The lenses are tinted dark to reduce glare, and when I wear them, the whole world takes on a brownish hue—while still protecting my eyes. I also have a pair for looking at the computer screen, often called office glasses. They help ease eye strain when I work on digital tasks. Lastly, I use reading glasses, commonly known as magnifiers. As I've grown older, it's become harder to read small print up close, so these glasses help me see clearly again.

One day, on my way home, something felt off. I thought perhaps my eyes were just tired from staring at the computer for too long. But when I sat down at my desk and reached for my computer glasses, I realized I had worn them all the way home from church without noticing. That moment made me realize something: each pair of glasses reveals a different world. The world seen through sunglasses, through reading glasses, through computer glasses, and through my everyday glasses—each one is distinct. And of course, there's also the world seen without any glasses at all. I find it quite fascinating. Each day, I live in different versions of the world—depending on which pair of glasses I wear. It reminds me of the saying, 'Beauty is in the eye of the beholder.' Clearly, I am here, and the world is there. Nothing has changed. Yet every time I switch my glasses, the world takes on a different appearance. The kind of glasses I wear shapes how I see everything around me. And then I wonder—if I were wearing the glasses of Jesus, how beautiful would the world appear?
