## Knot Drip Bag



### Easy Skill Level in US terms

Abbreviations	Materials	Gauge
Mr: Magic Ring	Medium 4 worsted weight yarn	3" x 3" Continuous Hdc Rounds
St: Stitch	4mm crochet hook	9 Rows x 12 Sts
Slst: Slip Stitch	Stitch Marker	
Hdc: Half Double Crochet	Scissors	
Inc: Increase		
Dec: Decrease		
Blo: Back Loop Only		
Flo: Front Loop Only		
Rep: repeat		

Note: The Bag is worked in continuous spiral rounds.

## Starting at the bottom of the bag

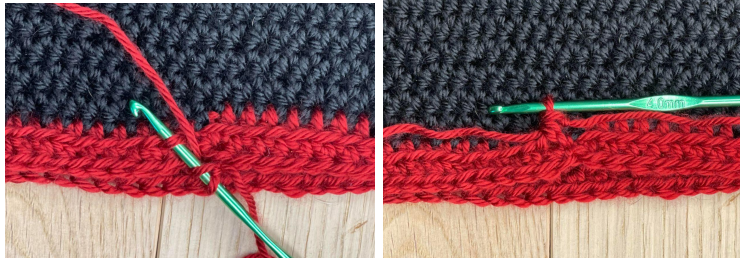
With 4mm hook and Bag colour

R1: Mr, work 8 Hdc into the ring	8
R2: Inc in each st around	16
R3: *Hdc, Inc* Rep around	24
R4: Hdc, Inc, *Hdc 2, Inc* rep around, ending with 1 Hdc	32
R5: *Hdc 3, Inc* Rep around	40
R6: Hdc 2, Inc, *Hdc 4, Inc* Rep around ending with 2 Hdc	48
R7: *Hdc 5, Inc* Rep around	56
R8: Hdc 3, Inc, *Hdc 6, Inc* Rep around ending with 3 Hdc	64
R9: *Hdc 7, Inc* Rep around	72
R10: Blo Hdc around	72
R11-21: Hdc around	72
R22: *Hdc 7, Dec* Rep around	64
R23-24: Hdc around	
R24: Hdc 3, Dec, *Hdc 6, Dec* Rep around ending with 3 Hdc	56
Note: Change to Drip colour in the last st of R24	
R25: Hdc around	56
R26: Blo Hdc around, Slst to the top of the first stitch in the row	56
Fasten off, weave in ends	

## Drips

Turn your piece upside down. With a slip knot on your hook attach a standing Hdc to Last Blo st in R26

Image Shows: R18: Standing Hdc in the Flo of the last st in R26.



Slst in the base:

Slip stitch in the last st worked before the chains

\*Blue crochet hook shows where to attach



R27: Standing Hdc in the Flo, Ch 7, Dc in the 3rd Ch from hook, Dc, Sc 3, Slst to the base

\*Flo Slst, Sc, Hdc,\* Ch 15, Dc in the 3rd Ch from hook, Dc 2, Sc 6, Slst 2, Hdc 2, Slst in the base,

\*Flo Slst in the next 2 sts, Dc 4, Hdc 2\*, Ch 6, Dc in the 3rd Ch from hook, Dc, Sc 2, Slst in the base,

\*Flo Sc 2, Dc\*, Ch 20, Dc in the 3rd Ch from hook, Dc 2, Sc 7, Slst 6, Hdc, Dc, Slst to the base

\*Flo Slst, Hdc 2, Dc\*, Ch 10, Dc in the 3rd Ch from hook, Dc 2, Sc 2, Slst 3, Slst to the base

\*Flo Dc 3, Hdc 2\*, Ch 13, Dc in the 3rd Ch from hook, Dc, Sc 2, Slst 5, Hdc, Dc, Slst in the base, Slst, Hdc 2

repeat from the beginning of R27, Work a Hdc in place of the starting standing Hdc

To finish: Slst to the top of the Standing Hdc, fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing the drips to the bag

## Sewing the drips

For best results, pin down your drips in desired positions before sewing.

## Handles

With your bag laid flat, count 28 sts from the edge and mark the 28th st.



Note: Attach Standing Hdc in the 1st of 28 sts

R1: Standing Hdc 7, Ch 1, turn 8

R2-20: Hdc 8, Ch 1, turn 8

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing the strap to the bag

## 2nd Handle

Place the Standing Hdc in the 7th st from the stitch marker



R1: Standing Hdc, Hdc 7, Ch 1, turn 8

R2-40: Hdc 8, Ch 1, turn 8

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing

Turn your bag inside out. Sew the straps to the bag. Sew in any remaining ends.

Turn your bag right side out and enjoy
