Discussion regarding a FCWSA audit. Members noted that an audit is needed for a grant. A motion was made by John Keen, second by Woody Patrick to hire McLanahan for the 2025 audit.

Discussion regarding House Bill 500, Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant. A motion was made by Jan Johnson, second by Roger Cada for Woody Patrick to contact GTUA to present at the next meeting on April 23, 2026.

During Public Forum Dale McQueen made suggestions for the board to consider including working with Greater Texoma Utility Authority (GTUA) who has the ability and knowledge to consider the financing of pumps and supply lines, grant requests, and structure for most impact and least cost for Fannin County. GTUA has worked with NTMWD for years in accomplishing these goals.
