The **Alessio Ge Foundation**, based in San Francisco, California, is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for people with disabilities. We are continually improving the user experience for everyone and applying the relevant accessibility standards to guarantee full digital inclusion.

1. Conformance Status

The website alessioge.org strives to adhere to the **Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level AA** standards. These guidelines outline best practices to make web content accessible to people with a wide range of disabilities, including visual, auditory, physical, speech, cognitive, and neurological limitations.

Our website is currently **partially conformant** with WCAG 2.1 Level AA. Partially conformant means that some parts of the content may not yet fully conform to the accessibility standard while updates are underway.

- **Interactive Media & Maps:** External embedded widgets, media players, or maps may not offer complete keyboard-only navigation or custom screen reader labels.
- **Third-Party Integrations:** External donation tools, form widgets, or social media plugins may present focus management or color contrast limitations outside our direct control.
- **Images:** Certain legacy images or graphics may occasionally lack descriptive alternative text (`alt` tags).
