

Whatcom County Youth Fair Opris Paul Memorial Scholary

The Whatcom County Youth Fair is honored to offer the Chris Paul Memorial Scholarship in recognition of the dedication and passion of students continuing their post-high school education.

This scholarship is established in memory of Chris Paul, founder of the Whatcom County Youth Fair, whose vision and commitment to agricultural education continue to inspire future generations.

Application Deadline: Applications must be postmarked no later than June 1 of the current year. Late and incomplete applications will not be considered.

Eligibility:

This scholarship is open to:

Any high school senior or college-enrolled student residing in Whatcom County. Students who have participated in the Whatcom County Youth Fair for at least two years.

Individuals intending to continue their education in community or university colleges.

Award Amount:

The scholarship(s) awarded will be up to \$1000 and maybe given to one or more students. Funds will be released directly to the recipient's educational institution upon submission of proof of enrollment and transcript.

Selection Criteria:

- Recipients will be selected based on the following factors:
- Scholastic excellence
- Demonstrated leadership and citizenship
- Financial need
- · Active participation in the Whatcom County Youth Fair
- A selection committee will review all completed applications received by the deadline and will contact the scholarship winner(s)

Application Procedure:

- Complete the application in detail and submit it along with:
- A recent photo
- · Three letters of recommendation
- Any additional supporting information (limited to 500 words)
