GOAT & SHEEP HEALTH CHECK STANDARDS

 **DO NOT RETURN AN ANIMAL WITHOUT FAIR MANAGER APPROVAL — NO MATTER HOW OBVIOUS THE ISSUE.**

Whenever possible, animals should be checked outside of the barn.

If any issues listed below are observed, leave the animal in its original location (ex: trailer) and do NOT unload.

ALL HEALTH CHECKS

1. Use fresh disposable gloves for each animal.
2. Checks must be performed by an Adult Superintendent or Fair Volunteer age 18+.
3. One person per division should complete all checks for consistency.
4. Practice biosecurity — wash hands, avoid animal-to-animal nose contact, and limit cross-contact between trailers.

GOAT & SHEEP HEALTH CHECK LIST

Check each animal carefully for the following:

Respiratory / Illness Signs

- Coughing
- Labored or rapid breathing
- Nasal discharge
- Eye discharge
- Fever appearance (hot to touch, droopy, lethargic)

Behavior / Condition

- Depression, separation from group
- Lethargy or not alert
- Off feed or not drinking
- Weakness or reluctance to stand/move
- Thin body condition / sudden weight loss

Mobility

- Lameness
- Stiff or painful movement
- Swollen joints
- Hoof rot (odor, discharge, soft hoof tissue)
- Overgrown or cracked hooves

Skin / External

- Skin lesions, sores, or scabs
- Abscesses or swellings (especially jaw/neck area — possible CL)
- Hair/wool loss patches
- Excessive scratching or rubbing
- Signs of mites, lice, or ringworm

Mouth / Head

- Sores or scabs on lips, gums, or nose (possible Soremouth/Orf)
- Excessive drooling
- Swollen jaw ("bottle jaw")

Digestive

- Diarrhea or manure staining
- Signs of bloat (distended left side, discomfort)
- Dehydration (sunken eyes, skin tenting)

Reproductive / Urinary (if applicable)

- Vaginal discharge (not normal for situation)
- Straining to urinate (especially wethers — possible urinary calculi)

Other Concerning Signs

- Neurological signs (staggering, circling, tremors)
- Any open wounds or infections
- Swellings that are hot or painful
- Sudden illness in multiple animals from same location (ask exhibitor)

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Scrapies ID
