ARAA 2026 END OF FINANCIAL YEAR, Postal Shoot.

Competition will be **SINGLES** only and may be SHOT on SINGLE / STRIP targets.

Targets from SISC or MISC will be accepted. (No decimals)

Competition dates are 1st June to 30th June and will be composed of:

60 shots for Master, A and B Grades as well as REST 1 and 2.

40 shots for C, D and E Grades as well as REST 3 and 4.

Competitors must be a Financial member of ARAA and may nominate for both - Unsupported and Rest Competition.

All targets for each shooter are to be consecutively numbered, and are to be endorsed with the shooter's ARAA Number, Name, Grade and Club as well as the date targets shot. An official of the club is to sign the targets.

Targets shot at the SISC or MISC will **ALSO** include the shooters name printed on the target or identity of shooter to be verified and signed by the Centre's Range Officer. (as per instructions sent to clubs)
