## ABOUT THE ARTISTS



**MAYHEM LI** is celebrating their 10th year as a classic rock cover band. Founded in 2015 by Drummer Brian and Lead Piano Player Xavier. Mayhem LI has been turning up the volume on their musical performances year after year. Solidifying their line up with Vocalist Michael, Lead Guitarist Andrew, Percussionist Ari, Background Vocalist Jonathan, Keyboardist Jackson and the newest Mayhember, Rhythm Guitarist Brian F, the band has evolved into a seasoned and entertaining band that loves to play live music just as much as their audience loves to hear it.



**TALINA** has opened for such notable artists as Joan Jett and the Blackhearts, The B52's and Jay Leno. She is a singer songwriter who has performed at such prestigious venues as Carnegie Hall, Citi Field, New Years Eve in Times Square for ABC, The Apollo Theater, the Grove in LA, main stage at the Columbus Day Parade and has been featured on every major television network over the past ten years. She placed several number one songs on the Independent Music Network and was awarded Best New Artist of the Year.



**MATT SAVAGE**, age 31, has had a remarkable 20+ year professional career as a jazz musician, bandleader and composer with ensembles of different size. He's played with some of the biggest names in jazz, including Chick Corea, the Ellington All Stars, Chaka Khan, Wynton Marsalis, Bobby Watson, Clark Terry, Jimmy Heath, Jason Moran, Arturo O'Farrill, John Pizzarelli, Joshua Redman, Terri Lyne Carrington, Jon Faddis, Jerry Bergonzi and Donny McCaslin among others. He's also opened for rock legends Neil Young and Stephen Stills, and has performed with Steve Earle, Jackson Browne, Shawn Colvin and Al Stewart. He is a Bösendorfer piano artist.



**ETHAN WALMARK**, age 19, began to play piano by ear at 15-months. Music — more than anything — positively and incalculably transformed every aspect of Ethan's life. Today, Ethan is proficient on keys/piano, guitar, vocals, harmonica, keytar, and melodica, and adept on bass, drums, and Double bass, and several other instruments. In April 2012, Ethan became an Internet sensation (+25 million views) when his keys/vocal performance of Billy Joel's "Piano Man" went viral. Mr. Joel was quoted as saying, "I think I like his intro to 'Piano Man' better than mine... Maybe he could teach me a few things." Ethan's has appeared on the NBC Today Show, CBS Early Show, People.com, and Connecticut Public Television. He has been performed at some of the most renowned venues: John F. Kennedy Center for the Arts, Washington, D.C. (Honored Performer), Lollapalooza, United Nations, Austin City Limits, and New York Stock Exchange to name a few. Ethan is a multidisciplinary (keys, vocals and guitar) student at University of Southern California's Thornton School of Music majoring in Popular Music and Performance.
