Trump Targets Worker's Rights

President Biden was the most pro-union President in history, the first sitting President to walk a picket line. Biden and Harris fought to protect workers' free and fair choice to join a union. The Biden Administration promoted strong labor standards, enforced rules against unfair labor practices, and created pathways to good-paying jobs for all Americans whether they went to college or not. Trump and Project 2025 will change the landscape of the American workforce and the US economy. Project 2025 calls for a mass firing of career professionals, replacing them with inexperienced partisan recruits. Project 2025 is anti-organized labor, favors management over workers, and is a recipe for a partisan, authoritarian government.

The speaker, Sylvia Woods, worked for AFL-CIO for 30 years and is a proud union member for 45 years.
