

ACDWC Board Meeting -- 3/2/2026

Ann Miller presented minutes from the 2/2/2026 Board meeting. Ebony moved to approve. Amy 2nd. All in favor.

Amy presented the Treasurer's report. 2024 and 2025 are now reconciled within \$10 from 2024. She is organizing the books to track designated funds. Ann Miller moved to send to audit. The membership list was sent to the Board.

Programs – Lore Stevens will present on March 26th (a Thursday). We discussed venues – Scarboro was suggested. Ebony and Amanda will look into reserving the meeting room at Scarboro Community Center. We decided to do \$5 pizza.

The group discussed having Sam McKenzie in April, May, or June depending on his schedule – perhaps making it a joint event with Roane Dems Dist 4 and the Roane County Dem Women. The African American Museum was suggested (knowing we cannot have alcohol). A candidate forum was suggested at The 201 Café&Wine Bar.

Fundraisers – The group would like to do fundraisers for the women candidates for county commission (Ebony, Sharon, Ashley, and Liz) in separate events. We can help other candidates as ordinary citizens and reassess club donations after the primaries.

Hospitality committee includes Amanda, Pat Marshall, and Sissy Byram.

Scholarship – Ebony reported that she made a packet with the main point of contact for each school and sent the info to the Scholarship Committee. Theresa Venerable is the point person for Clinton High School; Joann King is point for Oak Ridge High School; and Margot Spore is point for Anderson County High School.
