

October 30th The Liminal Plan

Approximately 25 people attended the October meeting with Chloe Akers, founder of <u>The Liminal Plan</u>. The organization was founded in January 2023 from the belief that Tennessee's democracy is broken, and the majority of Tennessee residents do not support the extreme legislation pushed by too many currently in state leadership.

The Liminal Plan is evolving, and will be known as The Best of Tennessee to create a long-term model for sustainable democracy. Their goals are to bring back effective governing; discourage polarization; provide transparency around lawmakers records and positions; and support &



incentivize lawmakers who want to compromise with their peers across the political spectrum. The Best of Tennessee is an effective government process organization -- not a policy organization.
