
### Glenville Rotary Club Champions Literacy Through Community Projects


Sheet Pan Baked Feta with Broccolini Protein: Add Chicken, Beef or Seafood

Feta cheese is a diverse cheese that can add bold flavor to any meal you're making. You can swap out the broccolini with broccoli or zucchini. Use cherry tomatoes instead of sliced. You can add bell peppers, sweet onion, what ever you like. Add cooked chicken, shrimp or beef before browning if you want; Make it your own!

- 1 15 ounce can chickpeas, drained and rinsed
- 2 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- 2 bunches broccolini, ends trimmed (14 ounces)
- 1 pint heirloom cherry tomatoes, halved (about 2 cups)
- 1 small red onion, peeled, quartered and cut into wedges
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt and black pepper
- 1/2 lemon, zested
- 8 ounces Traditional Block Feta Cheese, cut into 8 slices
- Italian Seasoning or Herbs De Provence

#### Instructions:

- 1. Dry chickpeas well on a towel or with paper towels.
- 2. Preheat the oven to 400F with a rack set in the lower third.
- 3. On a sheet pan, combine the broccolini, chickpeas, tomatoes and red onion with the olive oil and toss.
- 4. Season with 1/2 teaspoon salt and black pepper to taste, and spread out on the sheet pan.
- 5. Nestle the feta slices into the vegetables.



7. Squeeze the juice from the lemon half for over everything and top with lemon zest.

### Gluten Free Strawberry Muffins Freeze Individually for Later

#### Ingredients

- 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, softened to room temperature
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 cups gluten free flour Baking Blend (Red Mill)
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup buttermilk
- 1-1/2 cups fresh chopped strawberries

#### Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees then line 2, 12 cup muffin tins with 15 liners total and set aside.
- Add softened butter and sugar to the bowl of an electric stand mixer, or a large glass bowl if using a hand-held mixer, then beat on medium-high speed until mixture is pale yellow, 1 minute. Scrape down the sides of the bowl then add eggs one at a time, mixing on medium speed until



just combined before adding the next egg. Add vanilla then mix on medium speed until just combined. Scrape down the sides of the bowl.

- To a small mixing bowl add gluten free flour blend, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon, and salt then whisk to combine. Add half the dry ingredients to the wet ingredients then mix on medium speed until just combined. Add buttermilk then mix on medium speed until just combined. Add remaining dry ingredients then mix on medium speed until just combined. Add chopped strawberries then fold into the batter with a spatula.
- Scoop 1/4 cup batter into each lined muffin cup then bake for 19-21 minutes, or until golden brown and a toothpick inserted into the center of the muffins comes out clean, rotating pans 180 degrees halfway through. Let muffins cool in the tins for 5 minutes before removing to a cooling rack to cool completely.
- To freeze: cool muffins on the cooling rack completely then place inside a Ziplock freezer bag and freeze. Thaw in the refrigerator or on the counter.
