

Letter From the Pastor

Greetings Parishioners,

Today is Gaudete Sunday. So, I ask you to Gaudete! (Rejoice!) Gaudete Sunday is the third Sunday of Advent in the Christian liturgical calendar. The name "Gaudete" comes from the Latin word meaning "Rejoice", and it originates from the entrance antiphon of the Mass for that day.

Here are some unique aspects of this day:

- Theme of Joy: While Advent is typically a penitential season marked by reflection and preparation, Gaudete Sunday shifts the tone to joy, as the faithful anticipate the nearness of Christ's coming at Christmas.
- Liturgical Color: The usual Advent color is violet or purple, symbolizing penance. On Gaudete Sunday, the Church may use rose (pink) vestments instead, reflecting a lightening of the penitential mood. It is one of only two Sundays in the liturgical year (the other being Laetare Sunday in Lent) when rose vestments may be worn.
- Placement in Advent: Gaudete Sunday occurs roughly halfway through Advent, and serves as a moment of encouragement. The waiting is almost over; the light of Christ is near.
- Liturgical Elements: The readings, prayers, and music of the day emphasize rejoicing and hope. For example, the first reading from Isaiah often includes proclamations of joy, and the Gospel frequently highlights the role of John the Baptist in

preparing the way for the Lord.

Now that we are in the thick of Advent, we are indeed preparing. We prepare for the three comings of Christ:

- 1. Christ's Coming in History (The First Coming) In Bethlehem, in the Incarnation.
- 2. Christ's Coming in Mystery (The Present Coming): Here and now in grace, in the sacraments, and in daily life.
- 3. Christ's Coming in Majesty (The Final Coming): At the end of time the Second Coming, when Christ will return as King and Judge.

As we prepare for Jesus, please remember: you can request confession at nearly any time, as long as you give me a couple of hours' notice. During these confession times, it feels less rushed than during a typical penance service. I enjoy these confessions a little more and appreciate being able to offer them at times that suit you best. (Please feel free to reach out if you would like to meet.)


