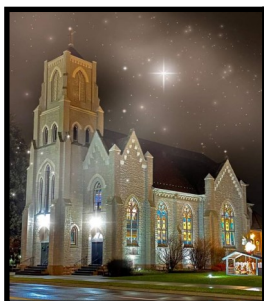
This 60-page guide gives practical suggestions for families to celebrate the liturgical year at home.

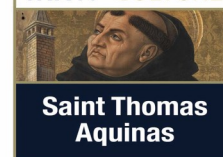
