Have a blessed long weekend!

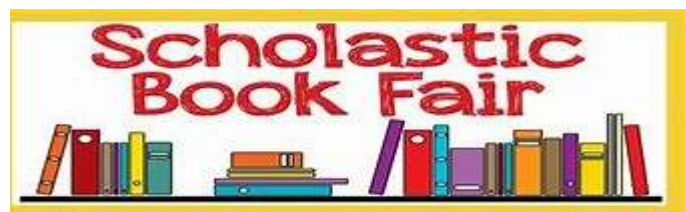
