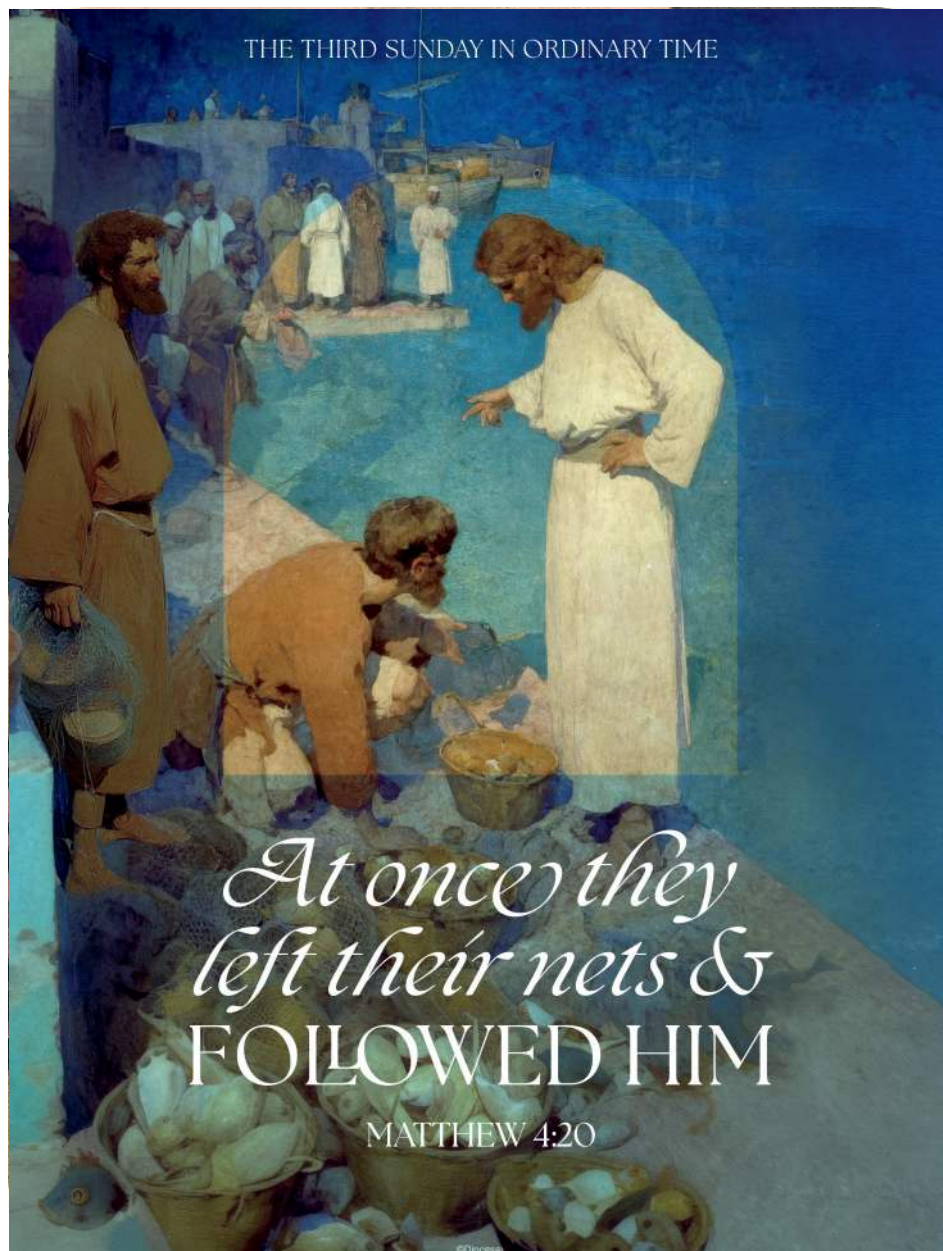

This retreat, three days after Lent begins, will help us experience the invitation of Jesus to, "come away beloved" to be with him in the mystical desert of the Lenten season.


