




- •Community Service: Volunteering for events, such as our local fish fry.
- •Protection for Families: Offering top-rated, affordable life insurance to members and their families, fulfilling the original vision of the founder, Venerable Michael J. McGivney, to aid families after the death of a breadwinner.
- •Advocacy for Life: Promoting the dignity of life by supporting pregnant mothers and protecting religious freedom. Initiative: A program designed to help men grow in their relationship with Christ and each other, fostering Christian brotherhood. Helping each other grow as saints!



The registration deadline is Friday, September 5.


