### Letter From the Pastor

(Note: This is a reprint of Father Jeff's article from last Sunday's bulletin - October 12, 2025.)

Greetings Parishioners,

Thank you for returning your two summer surveys concerning the intentional planning of our south school building! These surveys have greatly helped me and the Diocese better comprehend where we as a parish stand concerning our south school building.

Here are the results of the surveys which give me a pretty clear sign on which direction we desire to take:

#### A.) 1st survey was due June 30th

(This survey asked for what dollar amount pledge we would give to each option)

Option #1 = 86.6% of goal pledges = (\$86,683 out of

\$100,000 pledged)

NEED - \$13,317 more to reach goal

Option #2 = 40% of goal pledges = (\$74,535 out of

\$180,000 pledged)

NEED - \$105,465 more to reach goal

Option #3 = 19.9% of goal pledges = (\$74,427 out of

\$360,000 pledged)

NEED - \$285,573 more to reach goal

Option #4 = 20.6% of goal pledges = (\$99,526 out of

\$470,000)

NEED - \$370,474 more to reach goal

Winner with highest percentage = Option 1 demolition with 86.6% of goal

### B.) 2nd survey due September 19<sup>th</sup>

(This survey did not ask for a pledge.... Just votes)

Borda method= 4 points rewarded most likely option / 3 points rewarded More likely option / 2 points rewarded less likely option / 1 points rewarded least likely option

Regardless of which way the Diocese directs us, we intend to offer education for years to come in the stable and slightly refurbished North School building. This building has been reliable for the last three plus years in education of St. Joseph School kids.




