Dear parishioners,

Are you or anyone you know interested in exploring the Catholic faith? Have you been sitting in the pew next to your Catholic spouse for years wondering what you have to do to become Catholic? If so, this is a personal invitation from me to explore Catholicism through the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA).

RCIA is a process through which adults become members of the Roman Catholic Church. This consists of steps, periods, and rites that make up the model of Christian Initiation. Here at St. Joe's and Sacred Heart we meet on Thursday evenings for about an hour and half beginning in October until Easter. In the RCIA process each candidate has a sponsor. The sponsor is the catechumen/candidate's link to the parish. The sponsor helps the person to be part of the life of the community by introducing her/him to parish life and by guiding them in simple questions they might have. The sponsor does not need to be an expert; he/she is a companion on the journey.





LEARN BIBLE STUDY: GALATIANS











SEPTEMBER 22 OPENING PRAYER VIGIL!
