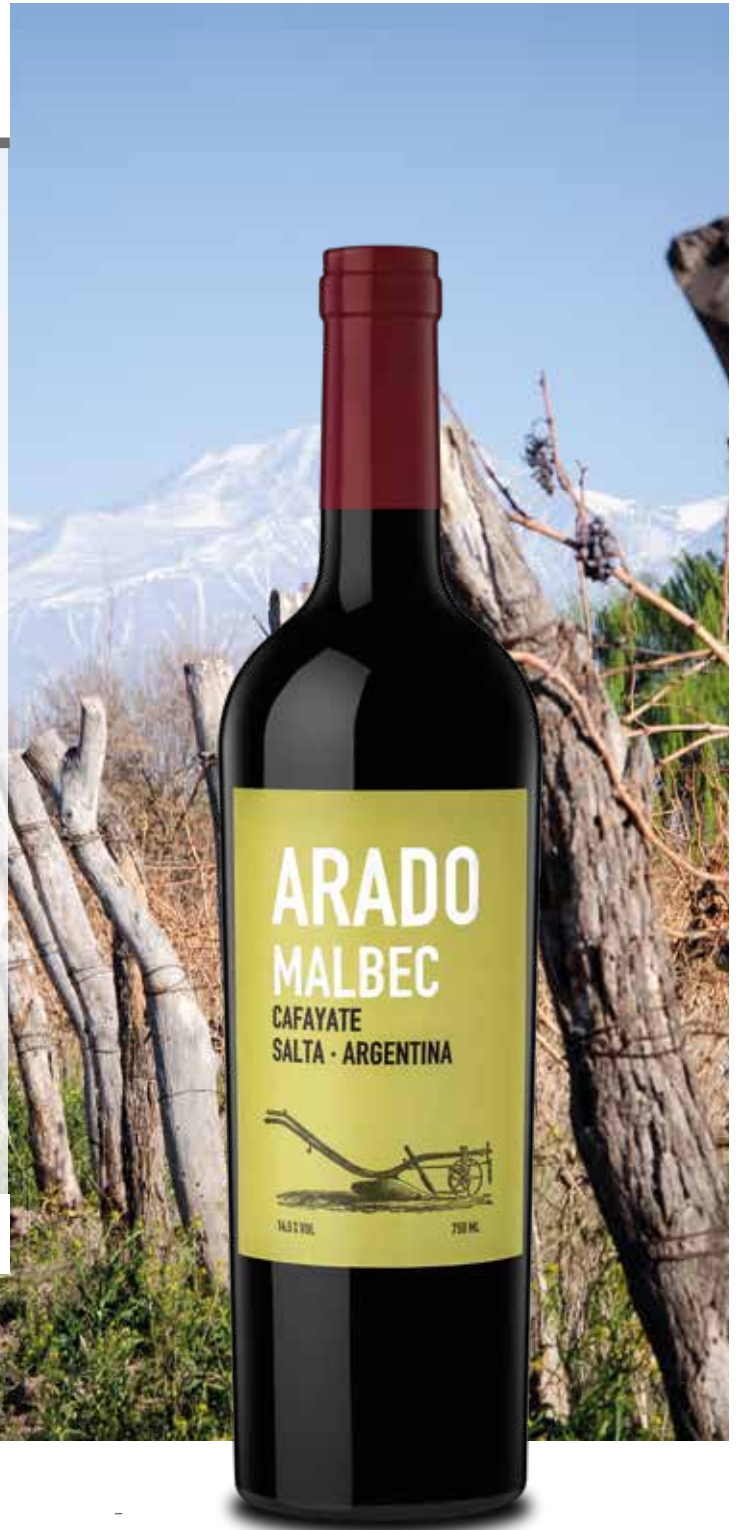
Arado is the Spanish word for plow (plough)

Arado Malbec is a fresh and fruity wine grown in Calchaquies Valleys. Deep purple color with aromatic notes of ripe red and black plum, and fine herbs. It owns great intensity and brightness, ending in an excellent choice to pair red meats and grilled vegetables.

Calchaquies Valleys is one of the highest vineyards in the world. Hot days with fresh nights provide colour, powerful body and fresh wines. 300 days per year of sunshine gives a great opportunity to the vines to the full development of flavours and aromas.

The alcohol is 14,5% and with 8 months in French oak

About Malbec:

Malbec is a grape variety originally from France. It turned out to be Merlot 's half-sister since they share a progenitor, the Prunelard. It arrived in Argentina around 'the mid-19th century and was planted in nearly all Argentinean winery regions. On the foothills of the Andes Mountain Range from Jujuy to Rio Negro. This great natural geographical feature separates our wine country from the Pacific Ocean on the western side. On the eastern side, the wine country is separated from the Atlantic Ocean by about 700 miles of land. What results is an area that has the perfect climate for cultivation: Continental Climate with poor soil and low annual average rainfall that is ideal for the cultivation of quality bunches of grapes.
